AT SANDY ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The year 1973-'74, besides being the Centennial Year for the Sandy Area Post Office, is also a landmark year for the Sandy Grade School District. The grade school this year will complete a building addition at the Firwood School and at the Upper Grades School.

This will enable a curriculum revision that will allow students to pursue a career education program that has not heretofore been possible at Sandy.

We may now offer an elementary program oriented to a technical-vocational as well as college bound endeavor. We see this as a major accomplishment for our local grade school students.

In a decade when so much is expected of our future citizens education has become increasingly important. We are told many of our present young people will have to change their vocations two or three times in their lifetime because of automation and related factors.

In today's education there must be no artificial separation between things academic and things vocational.

Our students should be equipped occupationally, academically and emotionally to spin off from the system at a point he chooses—whether at age 16 as a craftsman apprentice, or age 30 as a surgeon or age 60 as a newly trained practical nurse.

We should not have dropouts as such, only individuals who choose to go to work or pursue a different kind of education.

Thus entrance and exit requirements will be flexible enough to enable all persons to acquire educational and occupational experiences that meet their needs at a time they choose. In cooperation with our local high school and community college, we propose to effect a more relevant educational experience for Sandy's citizens.

In another section of this issue of the paper, you will find the grade school's proposed budget for 1973-'74. The building bond issue principal and interest payments are higher.

The educational staff has been increased to accommodate an enlarged student body and alleviate some overcrowded classrooms.

A new bus is to be bought and two more bus drivers need to be added. More custodial time is recommended. The fixed

charges have been increased due to an increase in staff and payroll adjustments.

The school board set all salaries in terms of averages paid in the various categories.

The budget for next year is larger. You are urged to study it in terms of the potential it has for our local boys and girls—good schools make a good community better.
