

Clackamas District reports conditions Free cancer check available

Road conditions: Several short sections of State Highway 224 are still under construction, causing some short delays.

The Upper Clackamas River Road, S-46, is open to Detroit.

The Skyline Road, S-42, from Olalie Lake to Breitenbush Saddle is in poor condition, and not recommended for travel.

Dump trucks are hauling rock over this section of road, making travel hazardous.

Roads to Timothly Lake, Highrock, and Hildaway Lake are open.

Trails: All of the trails in the District are open but only a few have been maintained.

The following trails have been maintained:

—Round Lake No. 565. This trail has been maintained from the parking lot to the Lake.

—Alder Flat No. 574. The complete trail has been maintained.

—Riverside No. 723. The complete trail has been maintained.

Campgrounds: All the campgrounds on the District are open except Scout Camp and Riverside. These campgrounds will not be open until we are able to complete some restoration and site protection work.

Ripplebrook, Rainbow, Raab and Peninsula Campgrounds are fee area sites. The instructions for the fee system are posted on the bulletin board near the "Pay Here" sign.

If you have any questions regarding the fee system, contact the Olalie Lake Guard or check at the Ripplebrook Ranger Station.

Fishing: Clackamas River. Anglers have been taking trout from 9 to 14 inches in length. Most of the fish have been taken on salmon eggs.

Commission sets regulations Picker shortage reported

Big game hunting regulations for 1973 were set following a public hearing in Portland last week. Seasons are similar to last year and little changed from Game Commission staff recommendations published several weeks ago.

The general deer season will begin Oct. 6 throughout the state, extending through Oct. 18 in eastern Oregon and ending on Nov. 11 on the west side. Again this year, no antlerless permits will be issued for eastern Oregon deer in order to protect mule deer herds which are still rebounding from a winter die-off and poor fawn survival in the past five years.

A High Cascade buck hunt will again be offered beginning on Sept. 15 and extending through Sept. 23. Hunters should take note that permits are required to participate in this hunt beginning this year.

Another film making use of Mt. Hood is now in the making. A crew and cast of approximately 40 persons this week started the filming of "Fair Game" an ABC-TV movie.

The film has a budget of about \$50,000 and is expected to be released this fall.

The Oregon Employment Division's Rural Manpower Service report stated that weather conditions are favorable for outside activities all over the State.

The report states that the Gresham-Sandy area is short 50 strawberry pickers, and the McMinnville area has a slight shortage. Help is adequate in strawberries in other parts of the valley and housing is limited.

In the cherry harvest, there is an expected shortage at The Dalles of 200 pickers by June 15. At Milton-Freewater there is a

shortage of 100, and housing is limited at both places. The cherry harvest starts June 15 at Eugene, McMinnville, Salem and Grants Pass with adequate help; at Hillsboro and Hood River, June 25. Hood River expects to be short 50 pickers with limited housing. LaGrande area cherry harvest starts July 1.

The raspberry harvest is to start June 15 at Eugene, June 20 at Gresham, June 25 at Oregon City and July 2 at Hillsboro and Lebanon. Gresham and Oregon City expect to be short 100 pickers each, with no housing.
