

Sandyite to lead salute to Disney

George Bruns of Sandy will be the conductor of the Oregon Symphony Orchestra during the musical salute to Walt Disney slated for Portland on July 4 and July 11.

Bruns is musical director of Disney Studios and since 1953 he has been the conductor, arranger and composer for Walt Disney Studios in Hollywood.

He is a native to the Sandy area and is the author along with Hoodlander Dick Sellers of the Sandy Centennial and

Barlow Road Days song, "It's Dandy In Sandy."

The "Fifty Years of Walt Disney... A Musical Salute" will be held on the Equitable Savings Plaza, at the corner of 6th and Jefferson.

The two concerts are slated to begin at 8 p.m. and will last approximately two hours and seating has been arranged for over 600 persons.

The concerts will feature music and lyrics from Walt Disney motion pictures and television shows.
