

Blue Marlin swimmers second

The Blue Marlin Aquatic Club returned this past weekend with the second place team trophy from the LaGrande Elks swim relays.

The local team has competed the past four years in this meet and this is the top team finish ever.

This meet is unique because all events are relays, which means four events in each race. The regular strokes of freestyle, breast, back and butterfly are used along with relays of mixed distances such as two swimmers swimming 40 yards, with one swimmer going 160 yards and the fourth swimmer going 80 yards. Also there are several relays made up of four different age bracket swimmers.
