

Reviewers continue to discuss charges against planners

The review committee investigating charges against the Clackamas County Planning department and its director is continuing to meet.

In a meeting over a month ago, several citizens walked out charging the committee was not doing its job and was taking too long to discuss allegations made against the planners.

Since the walkout, the committee has met twice and has planned its next meeting for Aug. 7 at the courthouse in Oregon City.

In the last two meetings, the committee discussed the school roof problems at

Welches Grade School and four allegations against the planning director James Hall by Mrs. Doris Gately.

Review member Carl Rhode brought up the allegations against the approval of the roof at the school in Wenme. He indicated the committee needed to investigate the county building department for issuing building permit for an inadequately designed roof.

Rhode stated, even though the roof was now up to minimum standards, it should have been designed for heavier snow loading.

The allegations by Mrs. Gately were

four of some 22 charges against the planning department and its director Hall. Mrs. Gately in a letter to the committee had indicated the committee had not reviewed the four allegations at an April meeting because of the lateness of the hour.

In the April meeting, Hall was found to be liable to a charge of malfeasance based on the allegations by Mrs. Gately.

Following the meeting last week, the committee has now found Hall liable to malfeasance, incompetency and a lack of credibility and communications for presenting an error-ridden coded zoning

ordinance to the planning commission and for the addition and subsequent deletion of a trailer ordinance from the first coded document submitted to the planners. The findings were made on three charges by Mrs. Gately.

The Draft Environmental Statement for the Salmon River-Roaring River Planning Units was filed with the Council on Environmental Quality on July 3, and is now available for public review.

Forest Supervisor, Wright T. Mallory said the statement outlines the various alternatives for management and indicates a preferred alternative as developed from public input.

Copies of the Statement are available for review at Forest Service offices in Portland, Estacada, Higglesbrook, Zigzag and Bear Springs. Local libraries in the Metropolitan area also have review copies.
