Cooking hints given

A secret pinch of this and an extra dash of that is the way most cooks finish off their favorite recipe.

If you admire their cooking and ask for the recipe, it's those last little finishing touches that never show up on the recipe card they give you. You can follow the recipe to a "t" but never can quite duplicate that subtle flavor or aroma.

Famous chiefs will often admit to that secret pinch or dash, but you'll never find out what it is. However, these same chefs will also insist that the secret pinch or dash is the same every time and the accurate measurement of ingredients is the most important step in cooking.

The second most important step in good cooking is to have fresh ingredients, because that is also where those subtle little flavors and aromas are hidden.

Another point to remember about fine cooking is that food residue left in an oven can affect the flavor and aroma of the next dish you prepare. Clean ovens and pans thoroughly before cooking again.

Remember these three things—accurate measurements for recipes, fresh ingredients and a clean oven and your cooking will have the touch of the experts.

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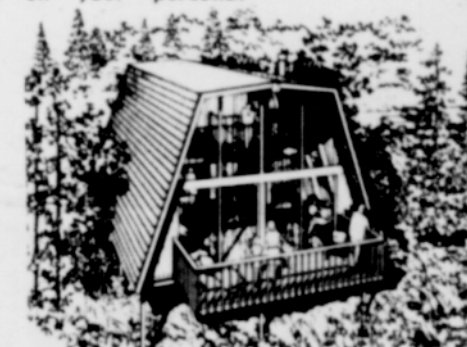
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
