Pioneers blast Central 39-18; meet Forest Grove for title

"How sweet it is," voiced Allen after seeing his Pioneer's blast the Central last Friday 39-18 for the league title.

Sandy and Central had entered last week's game with 4-1 league marks and the division title at stake. The Pioneer's jumped to a 12-0 first quarter lead and never were headed.

Forest Grove Vikings will come to Sandy Friday night with a 4-1 league mark and a 6-1 overall record. The Pioneer's stand 7-1 overall.

The Vikings, according to the Sandy coaching staff, are similar to the Pioneer's. "They base their offense around the run, but will pass if your defense lets them have it," said defensive assistant coach Mike Kostuba.

The two big ground gainers for the Vikings are Al Nordgren and George Harris. Nordgren is a 205 lb. fullback and ranks third in the league scoring standings.

His sidekick in the backfield, Harris, is a 185 lb. halfback with lots of speed, according to Kostuba.

"We'll need another good game from our defense if we are to win this game," said Allen.

The Pioneer defense, like the Sandy offense, is number one in the Valley division. The defense has especially been tough against the run, allowing only an average of 89 yards per game.

Meanwhile, opponents have not found the air lanes much better as the Pioneer defenders have allowed only 95 yards per game.

Mike Wecker ran the ball in for the two point extra point try following the TD by Turin.

"This win was a total team effort, the players, coaches and our supporters," said Allen.

The Pioneer's are hoping for great fan support Friday in the game with the Vikings. In fact, some extra seats are being brought in to handle the expected standing-room-only crowd anticipated for the game.

"There is no tomorrow after this game," said Allen, "and we want that league championship."
