

# What's Cooking?

**LASAGNA** 2 (8 oz.) cans tomato sauce  
SAUCE: Saute until barely tender  
2 cloves garlic, minced  
2 medium onions, sliced in 4 tablespoons vegetable oil  
Add:  
2 pounds ground beef and cook until red disappears. Add:

2 No. 2 cans tomatoes (24 oz. total)  
3 teaspoons salt  
1 teaspoon oregano  
Cook 20 minutes at simmering temperature.  
2 packages wide lasagna noodles cooked as directed

1 pound sliced Swiss Mozzarella cheese  
1 pound dry cottage cheese  
1 pound grated Parmesan cheese  
1 can mushroom buttons (optional)  
Layer in pan: Noodles, cheese, sauce, cottage cheese, grated cheese for two layers. Bake in a greased 11" x 16" x 2" pan or two smaller ones at 350 degrees for 35 minutes. You may freeze one pan and bake when needed. Serves 15 adults.

**NUT BREAD**  
In a mixing bowl sift:  
3 cups flour  
4 teaspoons baking powder  
¾ cup sugar  
1 teaspoon salt  
Slowly stir in:  
1 well-beaten egg and 1 cup milk  
Add:  
¾ cup chopped walnuts  
Let stand in buttered pan 20 minutes in a warm place. Then bake 1 hour at 350 degrees.

**BROKEN GLASS CAKE**  
(Serves 12-15)  
Dissolve 3 different 3-oz. size gelatins in 1½ cups boiling water each in 3 separate pans. Let congeal.  
PIE CRUST: 9" square pan 18 single graham wafers, rolled fine  
One-third cup sugar  
One-third cup butter  
½ teaspoon lemon flavoring  
FILLING:  
½ pt. whipping cream  
¼ cup white sugar  
½ envelope plain gelatin  
¼ cup hot water  
¾ cup cold water plus 1½ tablespoons cold water

Whip the cream. Dissolve the gelatin in cold water and then in hot water. Fold into whipped cream. Cut one-half of jellies into tiny squares and fold into cream. Pour into graham cracker crust. Put other one-half jellies over top. — From the files of Mrs. Don McKinnon, Burnaby, B.C. A light dessert after a heavy meal.

With the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays coming up you will want to begin baking special breads and storing them in the freezer. The following recipe makes a beautiful dark loaf. It's very tasty too.  
If making both Date and Nut Bread, mix Nut Bread first as it has to set 20 minutes before baking.

**DATE BREAD**  
1½ cups dates chopped in wide pieces  
1 tablespoon butter  
½ teaspoon soda  
1 cup boiling water  
1½ cups flour  
½ teaspoon baking powder  
1 egg  
1 teaspoon vanilla  
1 cup brown sugar  
Sprinkle soda on dates. Add butter and pour boiling water over mixture. Cool. Add sugar and beaten egg. Add flour and baking powder, then vanilla. Bake about 1 hour in moderate oven, 350 degrees, in greased and floured loaf tin. — From the files of Mrs. Don McKinnon,
