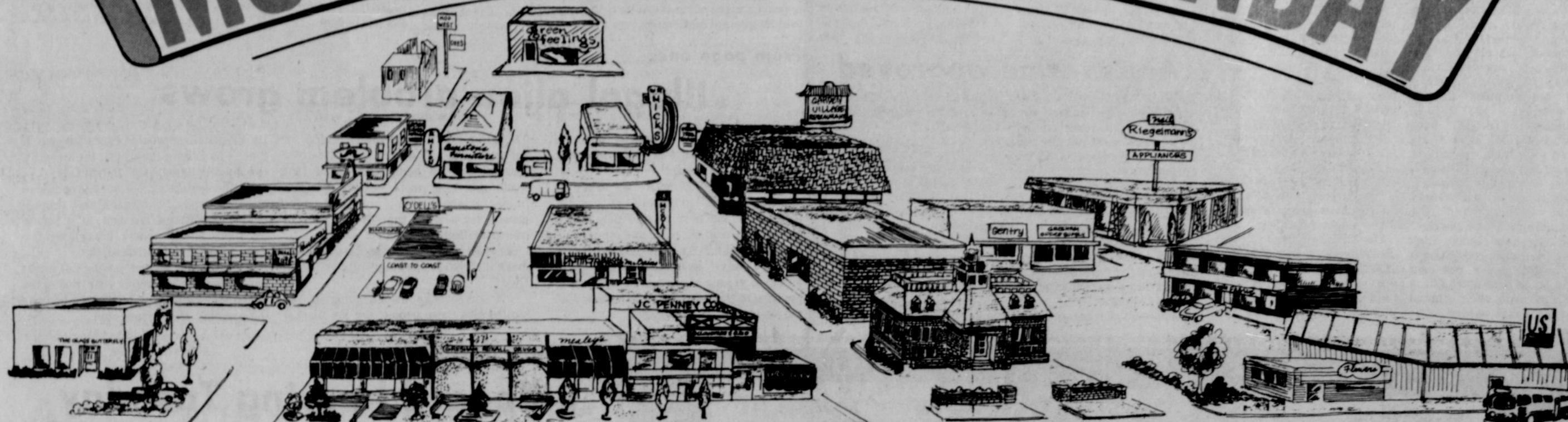
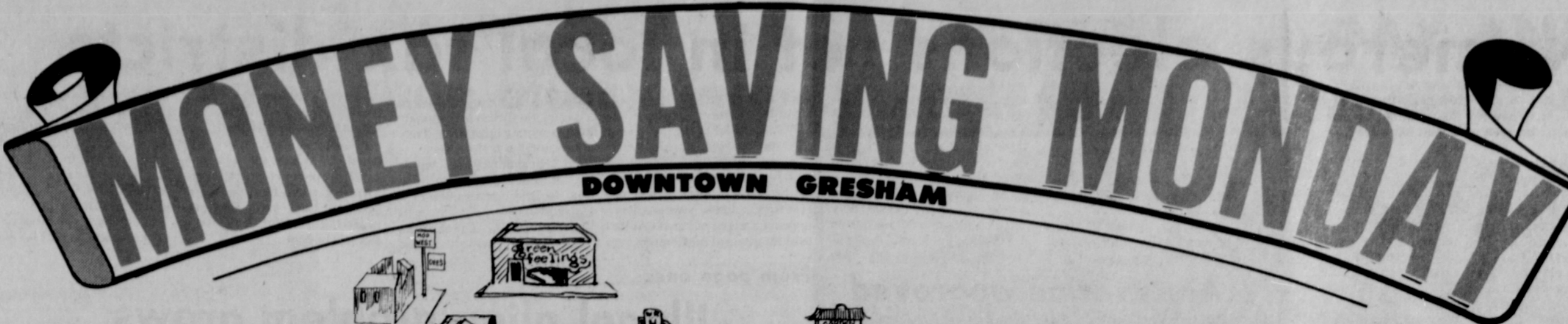

### Temporary injunction issued dealer

It also charges Weston hired five McKee employees. Circuit Court Judge Dale Jacobs has signed a temporary injunction against Weston. A hearing on the permanent injunction is set for May 19.

McKee is also asking \$20,000 in general and punitive damages.

### Train crash fatal

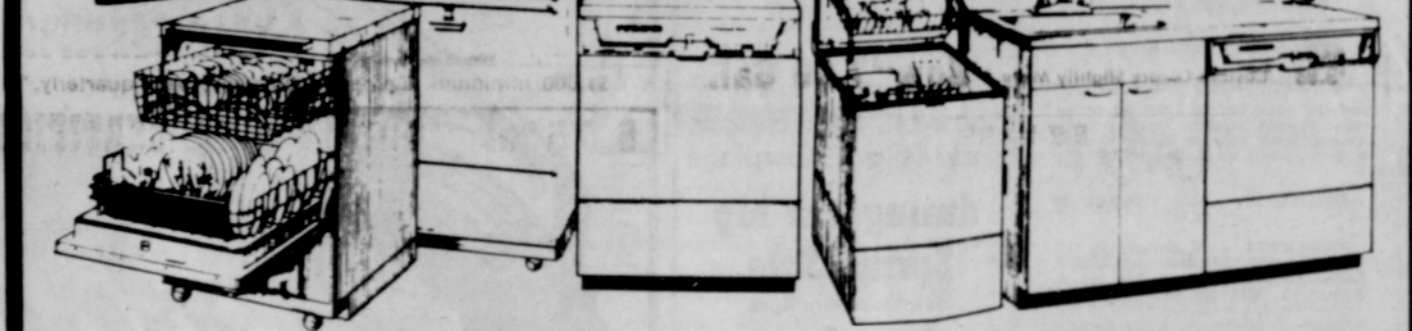
