

Mobile health unit to visit Sandy

Sandy area residents will have an opportunity to get a free update on health conditions as community service from the Sandy Seventh-day Adventist church.

A mobile health unit, sponsored by the Oregon Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, will be at the Thriftway Shopping center from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on May 18 to provide free tests for blood pressure and functions of the lungs.

"Many people have health problems that they are not

aware of and which need attention," says Sandy Pastor William Ring. "All testing is done by qualified personnel and when those being tested have conditions which need medical attention they are advised to see their family physician."

"We are fortunate to have this unit in our area as there is a heavy demand for its use," he continued. "Most illnesses can be treated if detected early and we believe that man can serve God more effectively when he is healthy."

The Portland based mobile unit was purchased in 1975 by the Oregon Conference of the church for health testing in Oregon and southern Washington. It is equipped with a machine which gives automatic reading on blood pressure and instruments for checking of pulmonary functions.
