

Pesticide container handling subject of new rules

New statewide rules for handling, storage and disposal of pesticide containers go into effect July 1, according to a spokesman for the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality.

Farmers will have an opportunity in the interim to dispose of any old containers. Presently only six landfill sites in the state accept empty pesticide containers.

After July 1, containers must be certified as properly decontaminated before they

will be accepted at these sites. Otherwise, they are classified as environmentally hazardous wastes and must be disposed of at the state's only site authorized to accept such wastes. That site is just south of Arlington in Gilliam County.

Proper decontamination consists of triple rinsing or jet rinsing of the containers or liquid pesticides at the time they're emptied. Rinse water is then added to the new mix of diluted pesticide.

Empty fumigant containers

must be decontaminated by standing open upside-down for five days.

The new rules require that each load or lot of pesticide containers taken to one of the authorized sites be accompanied by a certificate stating they have been properly decontaminated.

Such certificates will be available from county extension agent offices, DEQ regional offices and from most pesticide distributors.

Farmers will be allowed to

bury on their property five containers a year which have been properly decontaminated as long as such burial does not endanger surface or ground water.

The new rules also place strict conditions on the burning of fiber or paper containers, and the recycling of those containers for other uses or metal salvage.

Sites authorized to receive the unwashed containers prior to July 1 are: St. Johns Landfill (Portland), Klamath Landfill

(Klamath Falls), The Dalles Landfill, Lytle Landfill (Vale) and the Pendleton Landfill.

Further information may be obtained from a county extension agent or DEQ regional offices.

The new rules were adopted

April 30, 1976, by the Environmental Quality Commission following a series of public hearings. The rules are meant to protect public waters and public health and welfare from improperly disposed of containers.
