

'Sarsaparilla Theater' planned

ML Hood Community College Theater Arts program will extend a final salute to the nation's birthday with a summer workshop for the production of an authentic American melodrama with vaudeville.

The workshop, called "Sarsaparilla Theater" will perform July 29, 30 and 31 in the studio theater.

Dick Melo and Dave Spooner will teach and direct the

workshop, which is scheduled to begin June 22.

Any member of the community 14 or older is eligible to enroll.

Classes and rehearsals are to be 6 to 10 p.m. Monday through Thursday.

"We want to go back to the turn of the century," says Melo, "to a time when live theater and vaudeville were major entertainments in towns and cities all across this nation."

"New York alone had over 100 operating theaters and even the small towns in the West had small theaters where touring companies of actors, comedians, magicians, jugglers, singers, dancers, performed for our grand and great-grandparents."

Melo and Spooner are currently reviewing plays of the period and will tailor the production to the enrollees.

"Vaudeville olio acts will

intersperse the melodrama. These may be anything from barbershop quartets to magicians sawing fair ladies in half. We will concentrate on perfecting whatever specialties the students bring with them to the workshop," continues Melo.

The audience will sit at small tables with rootbeer and peanuts, and the workshop production will be part of the Sarsaparilla summer ac-

tivities, which includes a summer theater workshop should contact the admissions office regarding Theater Arts 253C, a three credit course.

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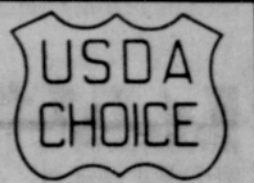
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
