

Mt. Hood Community College announces its plays for season

Mt. Hood Community College Theater Arts announces its new season of plays.

The first production will be a children's theater production of the Italian fantasy, "The King Stag" to be directed by drama instructor Dave Spooner.

The play concerns a young king and his search for a wife and the spell cast on him by an evil magician.

There are magic effects, talking statues and parrots, transformations.

The play will be performed

for school children from the local area Nov. 3, 4 and 5, at 9:30 and 11 a.m. There will be two public performances Saturday, Nov. 6, at 10 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. All performances in the Main College Theater.

The second production will be the mini-musical "You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown" to be directed by music instructor Dave Barduhn.

This musical is based on the comic strip "Peanuts", and will be performed in the studio theater Nov. 12, 13, 19 and 20 at

8 p.m.

The third production of the fall quarter will be the well-known comedy "Charley's Aunt" to be directed by drama instructor Richard F. Melo.

This comedy is one of the best known and most performed in dramatic literature.

It concerns a group of Oxford college undergraduates and young Lord Babberly, who in order to assist the love affair of his friend Charley, agrees to impersonate Charley's aunt, a wealthy woman from Brazil,

"where the nuts come from."

It will be performed on the Main Stage College Theatre Dec. 3, 4, 10 and 11 at 8 p.m.

The winter quarter will see two plays in production: "A Streetcar Named Desire" by Tennessee Williams, in the Studio Theatre, and William Shakespeare's "Othello" on the main stage.

In the spring, a contemporary drama will be performed in the studio theater and will tour to the Oregon Community College Theater

Festival in Corvallis.

Also planned is a major new Broadway musical, which cannot be announced at this time due to negotiations.

Theater patrons will shortly

Including summer productions, the college normally produces eight plays a year, making it the most active theatrical company in the East County area.

All district high school theater students are invited to attend the final dress-

rehearsals on the night prior to opening of any production free of charge.

Bus safety week slated October 3-9

October 3-9 in National School Bus Safety Week and State School Supt. Verne Duncan has asked Oregon schools to set aside one day to discuss school bus safety

procedures with students and school personnel.

Duncan said motorists should become better acquainted with a new school bus stop law which requires vehicles on both sides

of a road to stop when a school bus on the same road stops to load or unload children.

"Flashing amber means the bus is about to stop and motorists should get ready to

stop, too. Flashing red means the bus has stopped and motorists must stop and remain stopped until the flashing red lights are turned off."



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
