"If it's going to benefit the children, the Handicapped Child Census needs the help and cooperation of parents all over Clackamas County," Nancy Benson, learning disabilities specialist for Clackamas Intermediate Education District (IED) said recently.

According to Benson, the IED is helping to coordinate the handicapped child census in Clackamas County. The State Department of Education requires each county to complete the census twice each year, once in October and again in February. Children from birth to 21 with physical, mental, and emotional handicaps are included in the census.

"The purpose of the census is to be sure all handicapped children in the county receive the education and health care they are entitled to under state and federal law," Benson said.

"However, census information is held strictly confidential. State and federal law both protect the confidentiality of the census reports."
