Question Submitted to the Legal Voters of Said District.
BULL RUN SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING LEVY
Shall School District No. 45 - Bull Run, Clackamas County, Oregon, levy a tax in excess of the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in the amount of \$146,480 for the fiscal year 1978-1979, for the purpose of operating the educational program for grades one through eight?

EXPLANATION OF THE BALLOT QUESTION
The district has no tax base and therefore must present the operating levy to the voters of the district each year for the necessary money to maintain the present level of instruction now at Bull Run.

The purchase of a new school bus, a 22% increase in students necessitating the hiring of one and one-half teachers additional and other related costs thereto, plus inflation are reasons for the sizeable increase in the budget.

If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1978-1979 will be \$43,327 greater than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

Question Submitted to the Legal Voters of Said District.
COTTRELL SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING LEVY
Shall School District No. 107 - Cottrell, Clackamas County, Oregon, levy a tax in excess of the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in the amount of \$267,359 for the fiscal year 1978-1979, for the purpose of operating the educational program for grades one through eight?

EXPLANATION OF THE BALLOT QUESTION
1. Cottrell School District has no tax base, therefore, any tax to be levied by the school board must be approved by the voters.
2. This proposed levy is to maintain current educational standards; to develop a program for learning problems; to inaugurate a program for accelerated learners; to adjust faculty and staff salaries in accordance with School Board-Teacher agreements; and to provide adequate maintenance of the physical plant.

3. The 1977 Legislature authorized \$60,156 to be deducted after voter approval of the budget. With these funds and other reductions in levies it is estimated that the tax rate for school purposes will be slightly less than the current year.

If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1978-79 will be \$52,839 greater than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

Question Submitted to the Legal Voters of Said District.
SANDY HIGH SCHOOL SERIAL RATE LEVY
Shall School District No. 2, Sandy, Clackamas County, Oregon, be authorized to levy a tax in excess of the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, of the Oregon Constitution each fiscal year serially for the next three fiscal years on taxable property within said district at a rate of \$5.76 per \$1,000 of assessed value for the purpose of operating the educational program for grades 9 through 12?

EXPLANATION OF THE BALLOT QUESTION
The funds provided by this levy will be used for operating the educational program of this district for the next three years. A budget for each year will be prepared and reviewed by patrons. However, the rate will remain the same for three years, thus allowing better financial planning for both district patrons and the school board. The district estimates that this levy will produce \$1,749,312 in fiscal year 1978-79, \$1,824,243 in fiscal year 1979-80, and \$2,116,668 in fiscal year 1980-81 for a total of \$5,790,223 over the three years.
