

Labor Bureau to sponsor seminars for employers

The Oregon Bureau of Labor will hold a series of free labor seminars for employers in the Portland area next month. The training program is designed as a service to help employers understand their legal obligations, according to Labor Commissioner Bill Stevenson.

"Sessions will cover specific problem areas such as hiring, maternity benefits, injured workers, payroll records and recent changes in the laws," said Stevenson. "Each session covers new information so employers should try to attend all four sessions if possible."

The Commissioner expects the program to reduce the number of potential complaints. During the past year 1,669 of 1,887 civil rights complaints filed with the Oregon Bureau of Labor involved employment situations. Another 4,525 wage claims were filed in state.

The seminars are an updated and expanded version of the bureau's original test program conducted with 200 employers in Lane County during 1976.

"The program was highly effective in helping employers understand civil rights laws. The Lane

Council of Governments' Research Department tested participants before and after that training and reported that participants significantly increased their knowledge of civil rights law. Our 1978 version includes a new section on wage and hour laws."

Seminars on wage and hour laws are scheduled for Tuesdays, July 6, (Part 1) and July 13, (Part 2) from 9:00 a.m. to noon. Topics include state and federal

minimum wage and overtime regulations, time and payroll recordkeeping, employment of minors, wage agreements and employer policies.

Tuition on rise for fall quarter

Tuition at Clackamas Community College will be increased fall quarter by \$15 to \$125 per quarter for 10 to 21 credit hours.

The change was approved by the College Board of Education at its June 14, meeting.

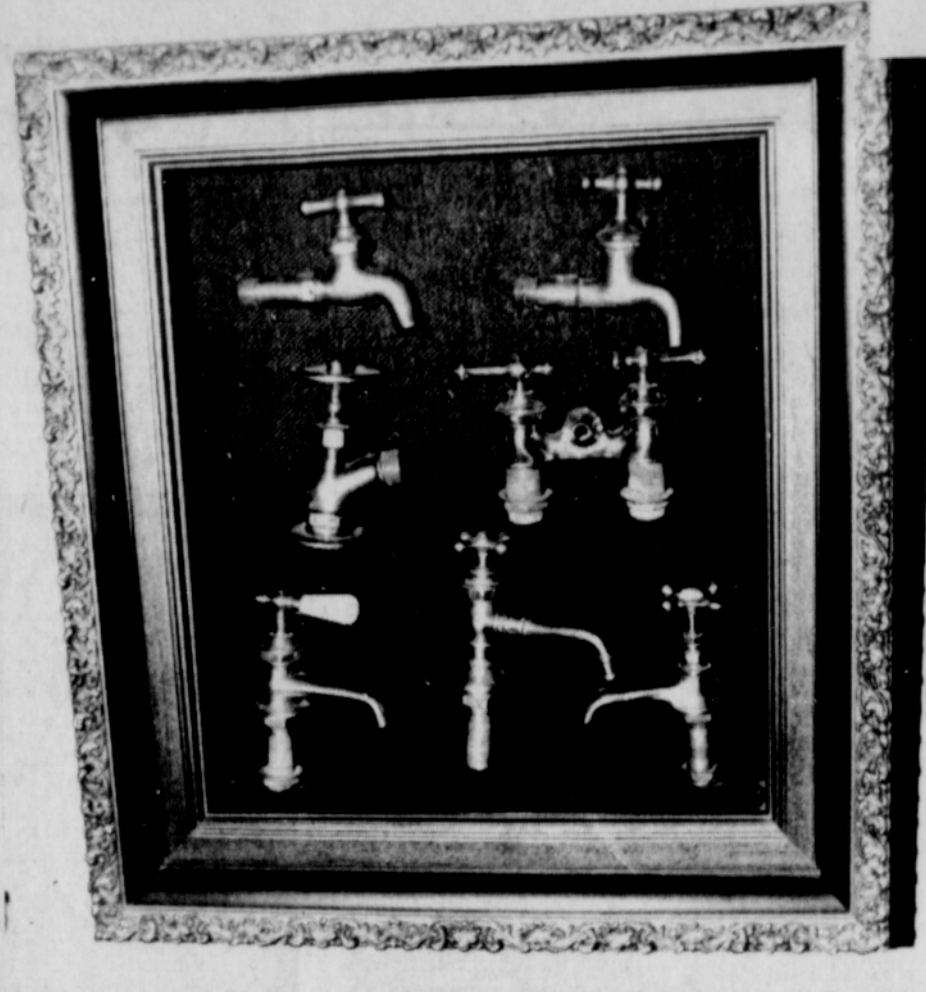
The increase also includes a raise from \$12 to \$13 for each credit hour under 10 credits and from \$.60 to \$.70 per contact hour for non-credit classes.

In other action, the board approved a change in the organizational structure of

the college's Community Relations office; bids for a jogging trail and a handicapped resource center were rejected; and administrative salaries for 1978-79 were ratified.

The board also asked that a committee be formed to review and formalize college policy on employing people under the Federal Comprehensive Employment Training Act.

The board will hold a special meeting June 28, to adopt the 1978-79 operating budget.

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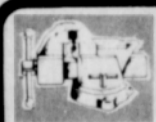


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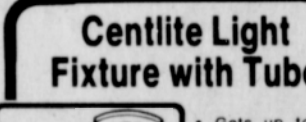


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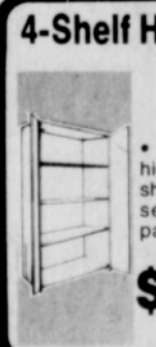


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Oral Hull news
