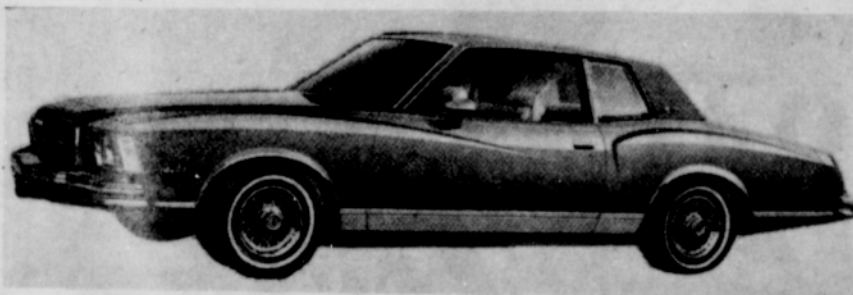
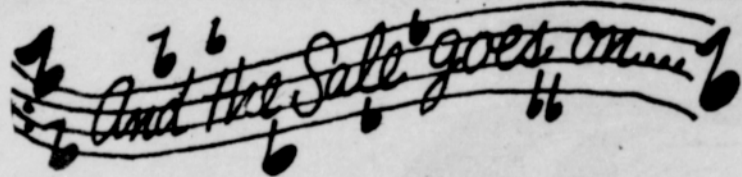


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## On the line . . .

## Sandy's strongest to vie in arm wrestling

Sandy is a logging town. And organizers of the Sandy Mountain Days decided that an old fashioned arm wrestling tournament would be appropriate for Sandy's logging tradition. The Oregon Arm Wrestling Association will present the tournament on Friday, July 7, at Pioneer Square in Sandy.

Sandy's strongest — both men and women — will compete for trophies donated by Sandy merchants.

Referee for the event will be Dean Christensen, current Northwest arm wrestling

champion who has placed second in world competition wrist and arm wrestling for the past two years.

Christensen presents arm wrestling tournaments statewide for Blitz Wienhard Brewery, which is responsible for promotion of the tournament.

Weight categories in the men's competition include light weight, 160 pounds and under; middle weight, 161 to 185 pounds; light heavy, 186 to 210 pounds; and super heavy, 211 pounds and over. For the women's class,

there will be a lower weight division for women weighing 135 pounds and under and an upper division for women weighing more than 136 pounds.

Weigh ins will be held from 6-8 p.m., with competition starting at 8.

The tournament is open to the public. There will be an entry fee.

Pioneer Square is located between Proctor and Pioneer boulevards on the west end of Sandy. Pioneer Real Estate, Babe's Big Boy Pizza and the Blushing Zebra are in the Pioneer Square complex.

## Snowshoe baseball taken from neighbors up North

A wacky version of America's favorite pastime will be played Wednesday, July 5, at a city-owned field off Tupper Road starting at 6 p.m.

It's called snowshoe baseball, a game borrowed from the Fur Rendezvous Festival of Anchorage, Alaska. But instead of the
