Boring discusses sewer problems

BORING — The Boring Area Neighborhood Group Accepted a land use application and discussed Boring's sewer situation at a brief meeting Thursday night at the Boring Fire Hall.

Donna Olson, BANG vice president, led the meeting in place of Lloyd Hinkhouse, president, who was absent.

The group accepted an application by Gene Schiedel to place a mobile home on 32 acres near Amisgiger Road and Rebman Road.

Boring's sewer problems topped the discussion list at the meeting. Ms. Olson said a 1960's Clackamas County study recommends that Boring residents improve their system of waste disposal.

"Some Boring residents have sewers that aren't up to par," Ms. Olson said. "And the DEQ wants them to do something about the problem," she added.

But there is a conflict with the DEQ recommendation. The state Land Conservation and Development Commission and the Columbia Regional Association of Governments have designated Boring as a no growth area. This designation conflicts with the DEQ stand in that added sewage facilities would take growth in a no growth area to provide funds.

A petition to Clackamas County Commissioners asking for a new sewer study for the Boring area was circulated at the meeting. It asks the county to determine today's cost per connection, maintenance and operation of a sewer system in the Boring area commensurate with new zoning.

In other action, the construction of a fruit stand at Haley Road and Highway 26 in a non commercial zone will be examined by BANG. BANG is usually consulted, but has not been consulted on this variance in land use.

Olson said she understood that all land use variances are supposed to go through groups like BANG through an agreement with the Clackamas County Planning Commission before construction on such variances begins.

She said she could think of three or four cases when variances have been approved by the commission without consulting BANG.

"Sometimes I feel that no matter what we do they please," Olson said of the commission.

Thursday's meeting was the last BANG meeting until September. The next meeting date, time and place will be announced when it is scheduled.

SE of Govt. Camp County planners O.K. expansion

The Clackamas County Planning Commission Monday night approved an expansion of the Wapinitia subdivision southeast of Government Camp.

The development consists of 25 lots on 74.4 acres two miles south of the junction of highway U.S. 26 and Oregon 35.

To approve the subdivision, the commission waived certain road, water and fire protection requirements of the Subdivision and Partitioning Ordinance. It also granted exceptions to state land-use goals relating to agricultural and forest lands.

The subdivision was previously reviewed by the Government Camp Property Owners Association.

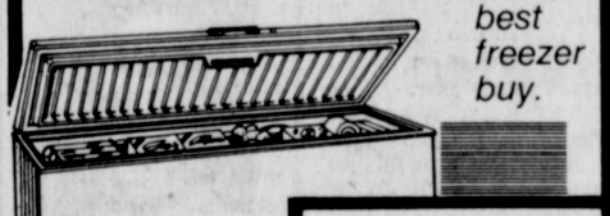
Police investigate fire

A spokesman for the stable told Clackamas County sheriff's deputies that foreman Karen Stamper pulled out a bale of hay she found burning in the stable Saturday afternoon.

While arson is a possible cause, Boring Fire Chief Matt Shields said, "There is a good chance it could have been an accident."
