CONFIDENTIAL REPORT: The month-old marriage of Donny Osmond is being swept toward the rocks and worried friends predict the superstar and his teenage bride will be in divorce court by fall. "It was a forced marriage and forced marriages went out of style in the last century," a close associate of the Osmond clan snapped. "It's a shame because what started as a genuine love match was turned into something ugly. This couple has no more control of their destiny than a pair of laboratory animals." Donnie, 20, and the former Debby Glenn, 19, were married in a lavish but quickie ceremony at the Salt Lake City, Utah, Mormon Temple. "You can see the hands of Donny's father George and his advisers behind the whole sad event," he explained. "Osmond senior thought Donny was breaking out of the goody-good image perfected for him. The marriage was a direct result of the panic button being pushed." Macho TV star Nick Nolte of 'Rich Man, Poor Man' and 'The Deep' married socialite Sharon Haddad in Las Vegas. Nolte, who had romanced some of Hollywood's top starlets, met Sharon about a year ago. He decided to marry her because, "She provides me with the kind of emotional security I couldn't find in women who do the same thing for a living that I do." The woman Nolte had been living with for six years, actress Karen Eklund, sued Nick for \$2.5 million, claiming they considered themselves "married" so she is entitled to a "divorce" settlement.
