WEST SIDE STORY

"West Side Story," the popular 1961 movie musical that captured 10 Academy Awards including Best Picture, will be rebroadcast July 11, on "The CBS Tuesday Night Movies."

The film, adapted from the 1957 Broadway musical that has pleased audiences all over the world, has become one of the top-grossing movies of all time. The popular score, with music by Leonard Bernstein and lyrics by Stephen Sondheim, includes "Tonight," "Maria" and "I Feel Pretty." Jerome Robbins' choreography was acclaimed on stage and screen.

Freely adapted from Shakespeare's "Romeo and Juliet," the story concerns the romance of a boy and a girl (Richard Beymer and Natalie Wood, pictured), torn apart by the tense hatreds of two rival gangs, the Jets and the Sharks, on the streets of New York.

Rita Moreno and George Chakiris (who both won supporting acting Oscars) are also featured, along with Russ Tamblyn, Simon Oakland and John Astin.

DADDY I DON'T LIKE IT LIKE THIS

Talia Shire and Burt Young, two of the stars of the Oscar-winning film "Rocky," star in "Daddy I Don't Like It Like This," to be presented July 12, on "The CBS Wednesday Night Movies."

Written by Young, the drama concerns mental child abuse in an Italian-American family in New York City. Eleven-year-old Doug McKeon (pictured) also stars as the unhappy son of parents Carol and Rocco, played by Miss Shire and Young, who try to make up for their own disappointments through the child.

Ambitious but untrained, Rocco gives up a career as a boxer and plans to go into business for himself. But in necessity of making a living, he goes to work at a monotonous job in a knitting mill.

Carol and Rocco unwittingly impose their own expectations on their son Peter, who is under additional pressure from the strict discipline at his parochial school. Unable to please his parents and teachers, the child seeks release in a strange withdrawal to a totally different world.
