The glitter and excitement of Las Vegas provide the backdrop for "Telethon," the dramatic 1977 TV-movie about romance and danger behind the scenes of a multimillion-dollar telethon, set to encore July 21, as "The ABC Friday Night Movie." In the film, the annual event hosted by comedian Marty Rand (Red Buttons, pictured with Dawn Rowan as his charity's poster girl) brings thousands to Las Vegas to see the stars and share in the glamour of the event. For Rand, however, the telethon is the last vestige of a once-flourishing career and he knows that unless the show raises enough money, it risks cancellation. The people involved with the telethon are also facing turning points in their lives. Roy Hansen (David Selby) must raise \$40,000 in one day or face a syndicate hit man (Kent McCord). I WANT IT ALL NOW

The unusual lifestyles and curious values of people who live the good life in Marin County—the wealthiest in California—and how their manners and morals are influencing the American way of life, will be examined in "I Want It All Now," an NBC-TV report to be presented Thursday, July 20. Correspondent Edwin Newman (pictured) reports.

Marin County lies just across the Golden Gate Bridge in the rolling hills of the Marin Peninsula. It is the center of a way of life not available to all, since most of the people who live there are affluent and presumably secure. But as producer Joe De Cola and his camera crew were filming, they found a frenetic undercurrent among the people which seemed to belie that security.

De Cola said: "We found that Marin County had the highest divorce rate in the country and a suicide rate which is twice the national average. In addition, it has one of the highest alcoholism levels in the nation and teenage drinking is a large part of the problem."
