Guillaume talks about playing TV's top butler

One of the most burning questions in television today is this: Who murdered Peter the hapless tennis pro in the hit ABC-TV comedy series "Soap"? Regular viewers of this season's most popular new show will have to wait with bated breath for the season premiere in September to find out the killer's identity, when the program takes up its new time slot in the network's already strong Thursday comedy lineup.

Nobody connected with the show, which has resumed production this month for its second year, is talking, especially not Robert Guillaume, the St. Louis-born actor who portrays the wily Tate family retainer Benson, a prime suspect if we are to recall the old cliché that the butler did it. However, Guillaume did talk recently by phone from his New York residence about playing one of TV's most popular manservants.

The response to the character has been favorable," Guillaume said. "There's no cynicism in Benson. He reacts normally in the middle of an abnormal situation."

Although the singer-actor considers that television is "not an actor's medium," he has done frequent guest shots on variety shows and series like "Sanford and Son" and "All in the Family" and has formulated definite ideas about comedy shows.

"Soap" is not about anything important," Guillaume reflected. "Most comedy arises from an artificial situation and you have to keep in mind that it's not real."

The show has dallied with such controversial themes as homosexuality, infidelity and spoofs of religion and Guillaume stressed another area in which the series is unusual, that of the servant not only being smarter than his employer but

also talking back as well. "We're violating preconceived notions," he said. "It has nothing to do with race and everything to do with class."

He added, "We eradicate the idea that just because you work for somebody you have to knuckle under to them all the time. Not everyone understands this but the part is best understood. I've noticed, by young people, who have to deal

'Carousel,' Oscar Hammerstein applauded him. On Broadway he took over the lead in 'Purlie' from Cleavon Little and earlier played a featured role in the musical 'Golden Boy.' He's also played Sportin' Life in 'Porgy and Bess' and last year was nominated for a Best Actor in a Musical Tony Award for his Nathan Detroit in the acclaimed all-black revival of 'Guys and Dolls,' which sparked

with the tyranny of adults, who feel that just because they are older and bigger, they can order kids to do anything they want."

Guillaume has said that he's an "actor who sings" and that has been proven by a very musical past. He appeared in operas and musicals at the Karamu Theatre in Cleveland, one of the nation's oldest interracial theaters. When he debuted there in the role of Billy Bigelow in

Without changing too much of the rhythm of the words, one can change the thrust of the role to accomplish this. "As it turned out," he added, "Runyon's idealized petty hoodlums were no better or worse or all that different from the rhythms of 147th Street," and one thing that the production's consultant, the book's Pulitzer Prize-winning co-author Abe Burrows, stressed that the cast found very helpful, was that "it was a fantasy, that nobody ever really talked this way."

"I have my own intellectual ideas about a particular character," Guillaume said. "If I'm any good as an actor, I can provide you with insights into that person. The art of acting has to do with this kind of thing."

Musical comedy experience and classical music training have combined in his background to give evidence of Guillaume's devotion to music but the performer (whose two sons Kevin and Jacques have performed with several musical groups) says he doesn't prefer one particular genre of music over another.

"A lot of contemporary music is derivative," he said. "There are so many influences inherent in any given piece of music that it's hard to classify anything nowadays."

He busied himself over "Soap's" break doing variety shows with Rich Little and Donna Fargo as well as an episode of the short-lived "Mel and Susan Together" and the upcoming syndicated "The Cheap Show."

But by now, Guillaume is back in California on a soundstage casting a sideward glance at one of "Soap's" zany characters and coming out with another of Benson's caustic comments for which audiences have waded through a summer of reruns.
