"Some people buy from me because they know I'm on the court and then others I'll just ask," Lanita said.



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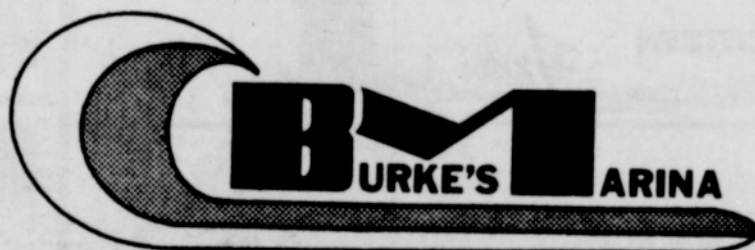
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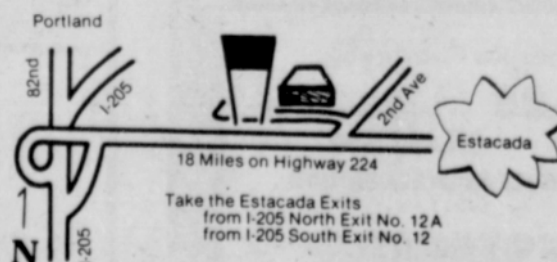
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
