

Helicopter rides on tap

Timber Festival goers can get a bird's eye view of Estacada, and the surround area by taking a helicopter ride during festival weekend.

The helicopter ride is a new addition to the attractions at the Timber Festival this year. The rides will be by Flair Helicopters, Inc. of Woodburn. The fights will cost \$5 per

person. The helicopter will take off from the Timber Bowl all day Saturday and Sunday.

Before machinery was brought into the forests, logging was done with the aid of draft horses. Horses will be matched against each other in the Timber Festival draft horse pull Saturday at 5 p.m. at

the festival grounds.

An arts and crafts fair will be at the festival grounds Saturday starting at noon and on Sunday starting at 10 a.m. It will feature area craftspersons who sell mostly handcrafted products including games, clothing, jewelry and wood item.
