Superstar Clint Eastwood (pictured) delivers another portrayal of a quiet stranger with a lightning trigger finger in the action-filled 1972 western flick "Joe Kidd," which will have an encore presentation Aug. 20, as "The ABC Sunday Night Movie." Set in New Mexico at the turn of the century, this adventure stars Eastwood in the title role as a normally peaceful sheep rancher who is hired by a powerful land baron (Robert Duvall) to hunt down a ragtag band of Mexican-Americans who have plundered a small town. However, what Joe Kidd discovers is that he's walked into is a long-standing cattle and lumber magnates and the Spanish peasants those moneyed interests have been trying to turn off their lands. Kidd decides to take a stand with the underdog and events build steadily toward a tense and violent final confrontation. The film also features John Saxon, Don Stroud, Stella Garcia and James Wainwright.

Two Harlem police detectives are faced with a baffling mystery, a rash of murders bearing the trademark of a gangster gunned down over 40 years ago, in "Come Back Charleston Blue," the 1972 comedy-mystery to be broadcast Aug. 19, on "The CBS Saturday Night Movies."

Godfrey Cambridge (left) and Raymond St. Jacques (right) reprise the roles of Gravedigger Jones and Coffin Ed Johnson that they created in "Cotton Comes to Harlem." Charleston Blue, a legendary black gangster, was slain in 1932 by Dutch Schultz, yet suddenly his trademark of blue-steel razors is appearing alongside slit throats. Gravedigger and Coffin Ed use their ingenuity to get at the bottom of the mystery, involving a celebrated fashion photographer (Peter DeAnda) and his naive girlfriend (Jonelle Allen). Donny Hathaway composed and conducted the score and sings the title tune. Quincy Jones was music supervisor. The film is based on the novel "The Heat's On" by Chester Himes.
