"Hi, I'm Julie McCoy, your cruise director. Welcome aboard the Pacific Princess. Hope you enjoy your cruise..."
For the past two years Lauren Tewes, who portrays the perky cruise director, has used these greetings to welcome the millions of viewers aboard the Love Boat (to be seen this fall on Saturday nights), the high-seas hijinks series that has enjoyed great success. The pretty 25-year-old blue-eyed blonde has made tremendous progress in her acting career considering the fact that a mere two years ago Ms. Tewes toiled in a Sunset Strip coffee shop as a waitress.

After getting bit parts in 'Charlie's Angels,' 'Starsky and Hutch' and 'Family,' producer Aaron Spelling signed the Pennsylvania native to play Julie McCoy in 'Love Boat III' which served as the pilot episode for the series.

"We've been working 12-14 hours a day consistently since May '77, filming the 'Love Boat' series," Lauren said during a break in the day's shooting schedule. By the time you read this article though, 'Love Boat' will have almost all its 1978 shows 'in the can' and the entire crew will enjoy a brief respite. According to Lauren, 'Love Boat' will not have any cast changes and will continue to have top-name guest stars every week.

Lauren's role will take on a slightly different twist with... oh, let her explain! "I get to run off with Tony Roberts and we have a love affair. Then in another episode my parents come aboard to tell me that they are getting a divorce and further on in the series the crew gets caught in a hurricane," said Tewes, who oohed and ahhed about the enormous sets that were constructed for some of the 'Love Boat' sequences.

And in case you're wondering how much of the series is actually shot on the high seas, "We sail twice a year and during that time we shoot parts of many different shows while the rest of them are shot in a studio. But our editors are the best and you can't really tell whether we ever left the boat to shoot the rest of the footage," Tewes added.

Smooth sailing
With a large cast that includes Gavin McLeod, Bernie Kopell, Ted Lange and Fred Grandy, one may wonder whether there may be friction between one another, especially after being in a constant state of production over a long period of time. But Lauren insisted that everything is

just fine, thank you. "We have an absolutely perfect relationship. After all, we are a team and we are all friends. When one of us is down we help each other out. We have to, after all, we've been together almost every day for the last two years," Lauren offered.

Lauren, who has been married less than a year, also downplays any attempt by the media to hype her as an up-and-coming sex symbol. "I don't fit the bill. I'm not an Angels (Charlie's) kind of lady. Julie McCoy doesn't have all the glamour, although she gets crushed, but she doesn't go out and seduce people."

"My Julie McCoy character changes from time to time and I usually discuss

her with my producers to see where she's going. Julie does things that I might do but Julie and I differ when it comes to romance, especially when it comes to marriage."

Transition
Lauren, who displays an outwardly happy-go-lucky charm, describes the emotional transition between acting on stage (which she did for several years while attending college) and acting in front of a TV camera. "They are both equally scary. I had no idea at first how you work in front of a TV camera. On stage I could be playing the same part over and over again while on TV I'm playing the same character but she's in a different situation each episode. I've fallen in love with film and I personally find it more exciting."

"I'm no slipshod actress. I work hard at what I do and I don't want to be locked into one character," she said matter-of-factly. Which prompted this reporter to ask whether Ms. Tewes foresees a change in her acting roles in the near future. "I'm interested in producing myself. I have my own company called 'Cody on a Horse Inc.' and I'm looking for all kinds of things about women, serious dramas, adventures. I want to be an actress for the rest of my life."

But does this mean that Lauren is thinking about leaving the 'Love Boat'? "I'm still having fun working on 'Love Boat' and I continue to learn something new every day. I also feel kind of nice when someone comes up to me and recognizes me and asks for my autograph. If the show lasts five years (series stars are usually inked for five years), I'll be here," she said.

Unlike other actresses who usually don't know what tomorrow will bring, Lauren knows what she wants and is steaming full speed ahead. A rare breed indeed.
