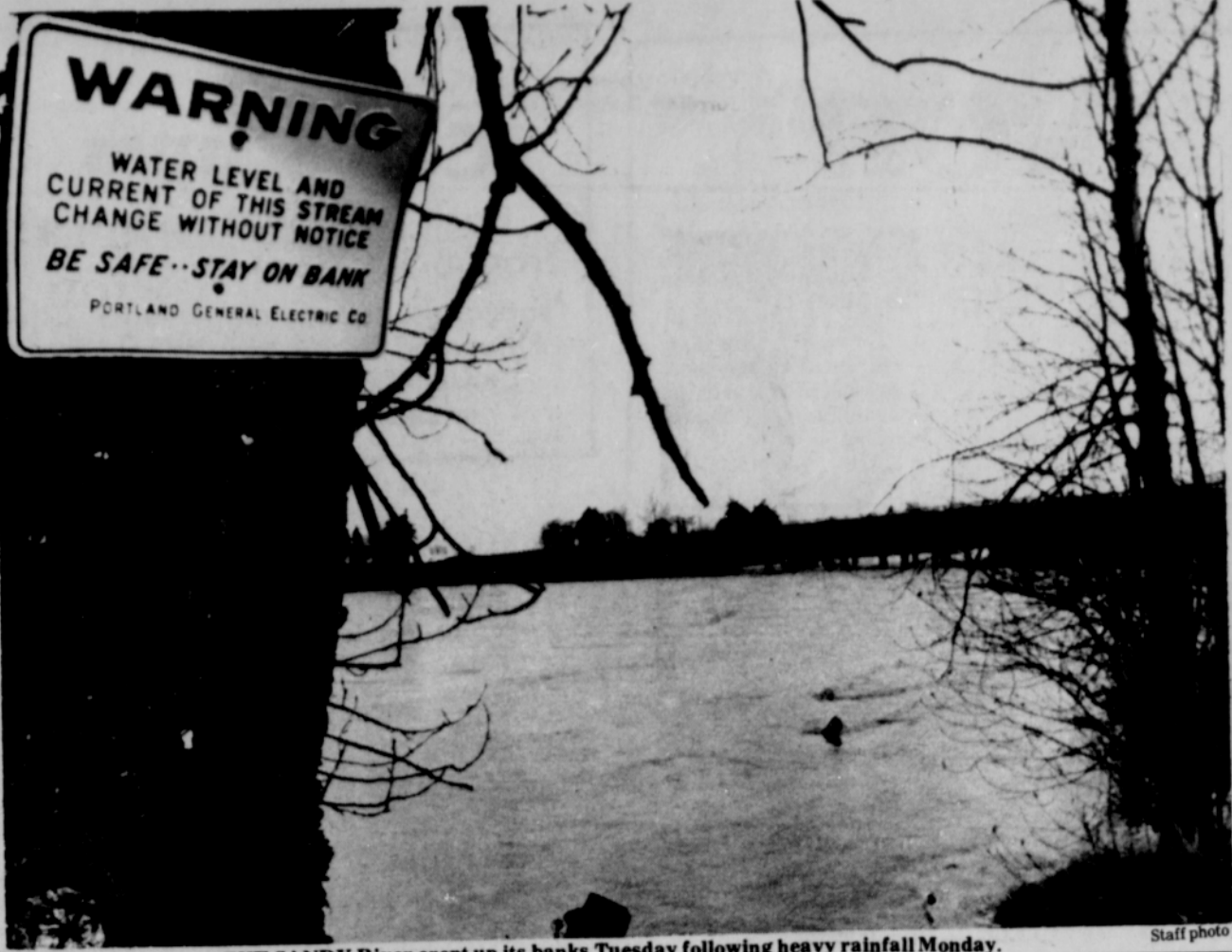




THE SANDY River crept up its banks Tuesday following heavy rainfall Monday.

Sheriff reports three Sandy thefts

SANDY — Three burglaries occurred in Sandy over the past week, sheriff's deputies report.

Over \$1,200 in saws and

mechanics tools were stolen last Wednesday from the Ronnie G. Long residence at 38960 SE Rude Road in Sandy. The thieves reportedly crawled in through an unlocked window while Long was at work.

Two burglaries occurred at the Barlow Trail Mobile Home Park last Thursday. A rifle, shotgun and some shells were stolen from Gary L. Wilson's mobile home while he was at work. The stolen property was valued

at over \$300.
