MHCC has welding, machine openings

Winter quarter openings exist for new students in automotive welding, and machine shop training programs at Mt. Hood Community College.

"We have space for up to 10 new students in each of four training programs during the day, but our evening programs are filled," said Lee Matthews, MHCC industrial training chairman.

Mathews said the specific programs with openings for the winter quarter are auto parts technology, import auto technology, welding and machine shop technology. For information call 667-7470.

Winter quarter registration is under way and new students should contact the college's admissions office for registration details.

The auto parts and import auto programs provide the option of two-year associate degree training or one-year certificate training.

Machine shop technology is a two-year associate

degree program with major emphasis on the actual operation of industrial equipment and tools used by machinists.

Mathews said jobs are available in these areas for men and women who have the necessary training.
