## Boring man jailed, fugitive arrested

Chris Sparks, 18, of Boring, was arrested Friday night by Sandy police and issued nine citations, including driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquors, attempting to elude police and reckless driving.

Sparks was operating a 1970 Dodge sedan on Pleasant Street between Straus Street and Ten Eyck Road. His vehicle reportedly caused damage to three parked cars and to yards and structures on adjoining property.

Sparks was jailed in Oregon City and was released on bail awaiting trial.

A 17-year-old fugitive was arrested on a Multnomah County warrant Friday and charged with robbery. He was jailed in Clackamas County and turned over to Multnomah county officials.

He is being held on \$50,000 bail.

An unknown person driving a 1972 white and green Plymouth took 22 gallons of gasoline from Smith's Chevron on Proctor Boulevard Thursday. The man entered the station at 2:40 a.m. and asked the attendant to fill his tank. The suspect then drove away without paying for the fuel, which was valued at \$16.50.

Mar Hook Co. on 362nd Ave. reported vandalism Friday between 8 and 11 a.m. Employees discovered that a

vehicle had driven through a chain link fence surrounding the plant, causing an estimated \$500 in damage.

Car parts left behind indicated a Ford four-wheel drive vehicle caused the damage.

Wesley Founds of Sandy reported the theft of a .22 caliber rifle from his pickup Friday. The vehicle was parked in the Thriftway parking lot on Meinig Avenue while Founds was eating in a nearby restaurant. The gun was valued at \$90.

Joyce Kramer of Cottrell

reported the theft of \$30 from her purse which was locked in an office at Sandy High School Dec. 12. Her purse was left behind and the wallet was later found in a trash basket with only the cash missing.

Three juveniles, ages 14, 15 and 17, were cited for criminal trespassing Thursday when they were found in a vacant house on Proctor Boulevard during the high school's lunch period. The boys were returned to the school for further disciplinary action.
