On Tuesdays:

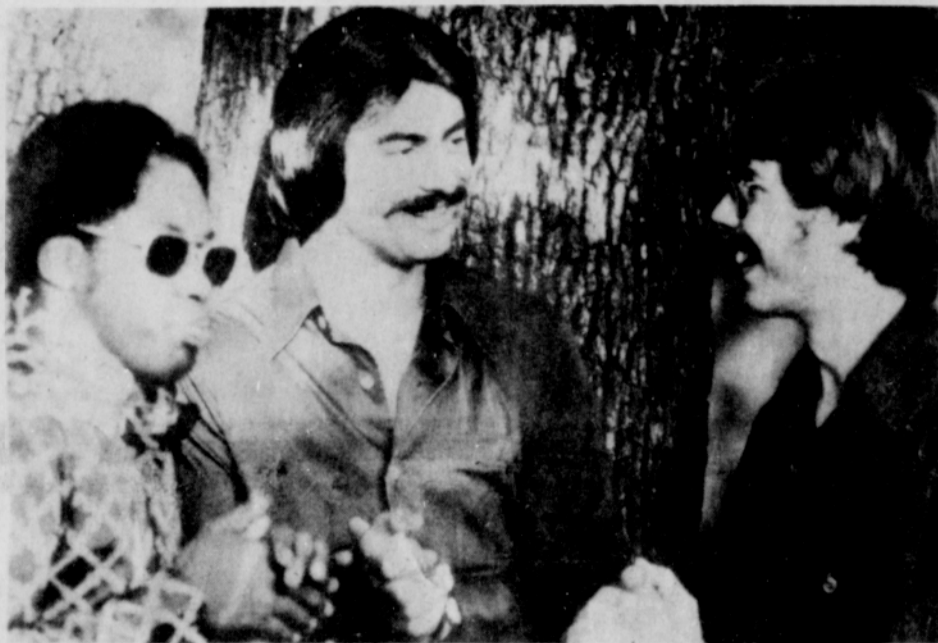
Tuesday pool tournament with single elimination at the Shingle Mill in Estacada.
