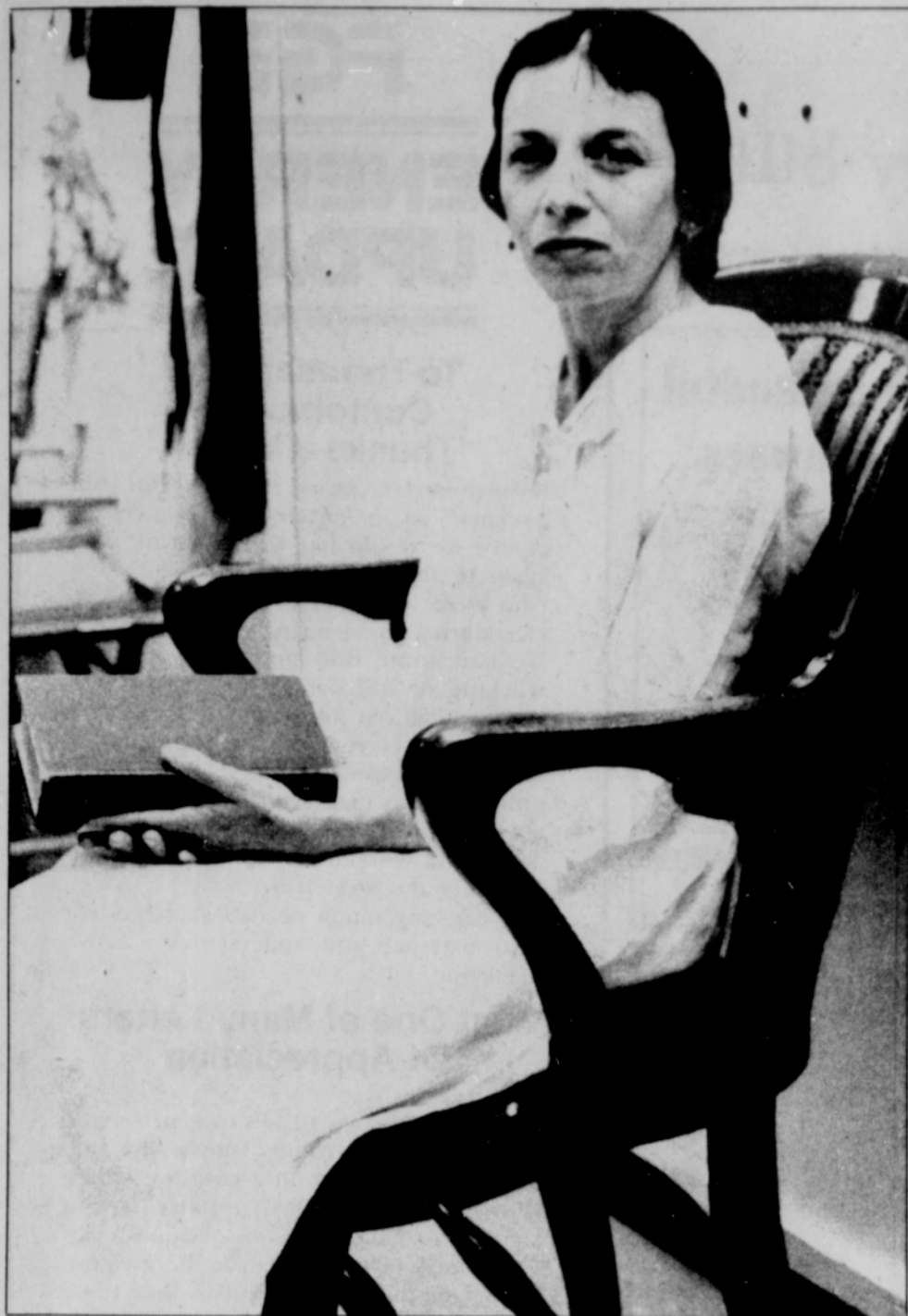




Belle of Amherst
