

COTTRELL SCHOOL DISTRICT

MEASURE NO. 32
Question Submitted to the Legal Voters of Said District:
COTTRELL SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING LEVY
Shall School District No. 107 - Cottrell, Clackamas County, Oregon, levy a tax in excess of the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in the amount of \$156,213 for the fiscal year 1979 - 1980, for the purpose of operating the educational program for grades one through eighth?

EXPLANATION OF THE BALLOT QUESTION
1. Cottrell School District has no tax base, therefore, any tax to be levied by the school board must be approved by the voters.
2. This proposed levy is to maintain current educational standards; to continue the program for students with learning problems; to continue and enlarge the program for accelerated learners; to adjust faculty and staff salaries in accordance with School Board Personnel agreements, and to provide adequate maintenance of the physical plant.
3. With the increase of revenue funds the tax rate for school purposes will be less than the current year.
If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1979 - 1980 will be \$109,146 lesser than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

Question Submitted to the Legal Voters of Said District:
SANDY HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT OPERATING LEVY
Shall School District No. 2 - Sandy, Clackamas County, Oregon, levy a tax in excess of the limitation imposed by Section 11, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, in the amount of \$1,607,498.33 for the fiscal year 1979 - 1980, for the purpose of operating the educational program for grades 9 through 12?

EXPLANATION OF THE BALLOT QUESTION
This operating levy is necessary to provide funding for basic school operations since the district tax base, established years ago, is inadequate to cover current operating costs.
If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1979 - 1980 will be \$203,162.00 greater than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.
