Sports Probe

A Look At Sports Medicine

What do Bruce Jenner, Rick Barry and Phil Garner have in common? Give up? They all have attended Dr. Thomas Fahey's laboratory to have special individualized exercise programs designed for them. Fahey who has published "The Good Time Fitness Book" has followed up his first successful publication with "What To Do About Athletic Injuries" which squarely confronts the common problems arising from athletic injuries and provides valuable tips on how to treat and prevent them. The initial response to the book and Dr. Fahey in general has been promising.

The San Francisco born Fahey is a dynamic individual whose own love for athletics spurred his interest in physical fitness as a science. His boyish good looks have also helped him promote his theories and book via AM Los Angeles, AM Chicago and Dinah media routes.

Common Problems

Speaking from his office on the coast Fahey discussed what he has found to be the most frequent injury amongst the pro, amateur and weekend athletes. Today we are seeing more and more over-use injuries such as tendonitis and bursitis which is coming from inappropriate exercise. Some people try to do too much too soon. For instance some of these injuries come from tennis (tennis elbow) Well you need to develop a good stroke, upper body

strength and have good equipment in order to avoid some of these injuries," said Fahey.

But with the advent of sports medicine and the great technological advances the field has made in the last decade Dr. Fahey and his colleagues have been able to treat these injuries with better results and have been able to foment change in how the average American should approach athletics. More progress has been made in the last 12 years of sports medicine than in all of history. With the introduction of radioactive and chemistry techniques the methods of studying the injuries and the setting up of new exercise programs, things are getting a bit more sophisticated and evidently more reliable," the handsome Fahey added.

The radioactive and chemical applications Dr. Fahey alluded to, are the mainstream branches of sports medicine. Physiology deals with the actual chemical functions of the body while Kinesiology is the study of motion. When a pitcher talks about the mechanics of his pitching he is referring to Kinesiology. Mike Marshall the veteran relief pitcher for the Minnesota Twins has a degree in Kinesiology and has been able to make a stunning comeback to the major leagues.

Criticism

While Dr. Fahey is pleased with the progress that sports medicine has made he is disappointed with the pro and amateur sports scene in this country. Said a perturbed Dr. Fahey, "There is no national sports center per se in this country to further the study of these injuries and as such sports medicine is not being employed properly in this country especially in pro sports. In pro sports astroturf was supposed to be a promising development as far as cutting down on leg injuries were concerned but unfortunately the game is faster on astro-turf, the surface is harder and that means the usage of shorter cleats worn by athletes to cut down on those injuries has been negated.

As far as the Olympics are concerned, we should be on par with the East Europeans. We have more potential Olympians per square mile than any other place in the world but again nobody is taking care of them. We need the government to take more steps to fund these athletes. In Eastern Europe they develop their athletes during their growing years and have more doctors available to them than anywhere else. Hopefully this country will realize these problems and correct them."
