

Probing The Telepathic Mind

Mental telepathy? To most of us the power to probe another person's thoughts is, indeed, a strange phenomenon. But to Kreskin, the world's foremost mentalist, ESP is not so amazing.

"I don't even call it psychic," Kreskin asserts. "I've always maintained that I don't have any supernatural ability. I consider it a heightened sensitivity. I've raised to a higher threshold a lot of abilities that are inherent in everyone."

By directing a person to concentrate on a word or thought, Kreskin is able to visualize a facsimile of that image in his mind's eye—often with embarrassing accuracy.

After giving those directions to his audience at Rutgers College in New Brunswick, N.J., Kreskin zeroed in on a distinct image of a steering wheel. The young man who telegraphed that message stood up.

With a tight lip and closed eyes, Kreskin ascertained that the steering wheel was in a parked car or van. For a moment he looked puzzled, yet beneath his wrinkled forehead there was a calm self-assurance that he would decipher the mental puzzle forming in his mind. Kreskin looked the student straight in the eye. "Does the name Beth mean anything to you?"

The abashed young man sat down.

At his live performances Kreskin

Canadian telecast for the season, Kreskin thought he had hit upon an interesting twist to his mind-reading antics: from atop the Canadian National building in Toronto he would attempt to read the thoughts of a man hovering outside in a helicopter.

But when the CTV Network filmed it, the chopper bobbed up and down in the wind, sometimes instantly dropping ten stories in the violent downdrafts. While viewers watched aghast as the pilot fought to maneuver his craft, Kreskin watched from inside trying to visualize the passenger's thoughts on his "mind screen." After repeated attempts however, time ran out and the communication link failed.

Had it been any other type of show, the scene would have been reshoot. But Kreskin has always taken pride in the fact that his programs are never reshoot or edited (except for time). And his Canadian fans tell him that last episode was one of his most memorable shows.

The language barrier

Language posed a problem in filming a 90-minute special in Japan. Although his programs there are normally dubbed in Japanese, Kreskin wanted the special to be as true-to-life and credible as possible. (Unfortunately Kreskin didn't speak Japanese.) "Obviously if a person doesn't think in terms of the concepts I understand, I can't do a darn thing. The solution was I had to think in terms of pictures." In a dramatic scene, Kreskin used interpreters to reconstruct the world tour of a ship's captain who was standing on a dock 200 miles away.

Although extra-sensory perception has evolved into an arcane practice, it is, Kreskin says, innate in everyone to varying degrees. He points out that many of the isolated jungle tribes of Africa possess some form of ESP, but he is quick to add that in our culture things are different. "I think as we grow older and as society becomes more complex, a lot of the need for the more subtle ways of perceiving go along the way-side," he said.

While most of us have let our sixth sense atrophy, Kreskin has developed his ability, through constant practice, to a remarkable degree. And the result is amazing, even if Kreskin doesn't always think so.

routinely recites social security numbers from inside a woman's pocketbook 100 feet away, sniffs out his paycheck in a mental game of hot 'n cold and reads thoughts from people's past as easily as if he were reading a newspaper over their shoulder.

How does he do it? As Kreskin explains the process, "It's almost as though I'm trying to focus on a television screen in my mind."

Not all of Kreskin's thoughts, though, are in pictures. He also performs automatic writing, which he says most people can be trained to do. "I can take a pencil and rest it on a pad, and when I'm conversing with you my hand would start to write and move—even though I wouldn't be that conscious of what I was writing."

World renown

Literally millions of people worldwide have been touched by Kreskin's spellbinding skills. He is a familiar face in many foreign countries including the United Kingdom, Australia, New Zealand and Japan. In the United States he has appeared on "Mike Douglas" over 100 times and both the "Merv Griffin Show" and "The Tonight Show" over 80 times.

In Canada, the insatiable desire for Kreskin's mystifying feats continues with regular syndicated broadcasts of his weekly "The Amazing World of Kreskin."

Despite his fame, Kreskin admits he is not always successful. In filming the final segment of his

George Benson

George Benson is an enigma. He defies classification. He has often been characterized as the greatest living jazz guitarist of all time. In recent years, his musical horizons have broadened immensely, and while his roots remain deeply entrenched in the jazz idiom, the Benson musical experience is now all encompassing.

In a sense, the 36-year-old vocalist/guitarist has outgrown his critics. His music has been honed to a fine art. Relying primarily on instincts, Benson has meshed his subtle and eloquent guitar style with maturing vocal presence and an uncanny sense for melody, and space.

While critics remain pragmatic and restrictive, Benson's intuition for "playing what he feels," continues to keep him at least two steps ahead of his audience. In fact, in the past three years he has emerged as somewhat of an across-the-board people's hero.

He not only was responsible for the biggest-selling jazz album of all time, *Breezin'*, but he has also had three platinum albums in succession, *Breezin'*, *In Flight* and *Weekend In L.A.* In 1976 he captured three Grammys. In addition, all three of his albums dominated the best-selling jazz charts while establishing him as the leading cross-over jazz artist in the past decade.

Undeniably, the release of *Breezin'* opened the door for Benson and jazz, a door that had long been jammed shut. The tumultuous response to "This Masquerade" not only made it a jazz classic, but also jetted it to No. 1 in the pop singles charts.

Live! Inside Your Love, his most recent album, is a further extension of the Benson persona, fusing the distinctive elements of his musical heritage with his ability to set new musical environments. The double-record set interacts vintage Benson instrumentals with his equally scintillating vocals.

It is a melting pot of Benson's varied influences and allows his total diversity to come to the fore on a number of original tunes including the latin-tinged "Before You Go," the melodic and jazzy "You're Never Too Far From Me," and the high energy and swinging "Welcome Into My World."

Live! Inside Your Love should finally quiet antagonists about which direction Benson is pursuing. One thing is for sure, whatever George Benson does, he does with taste, sensitivity and eloquence—that is the real beauty of the man and his music.
