### Tough role tests Wagner's 'Scruples'

New York—Since Lindsay Wagner's departure from her Emmy Award-winning series 'Bionic Woman,' the gorgeous blonde has fought long and hard to rid herself of the Jamie Sommers persona, tackling impressive time-period roles in 'Dr. Meg Laurel' and 'Jenny Logan.'

This week Lindsay will grace the small screen in perhaps her most controversial role since 'Paper Chase,' when she headlines in the tele-version of Judith Krantz's pot-boiling best-seller 'Scruples.' Lindsay portrays Billy Ikehorn, the chic owner of the most exclusive shop on Rodeo Drive in Beverly Hills.



### Focus

The book has an overabundance of lurid sex, but according to Ms. Wagner, who is currently lensing a police action thriller flick, 'Hawks,' on location in New York with Sly Stallone, the TV version has been "sanitized."

"We've literally taken out all of the sex and focused on the main character (Ikehorn) and on the development of her personal life. We don't get involved too much with the fashion industry, either," said the 30-year-old actress.

Lindsay does admit, though, that she wasn't too crazy about doing 'Scruples' when it was originally thrust in her direction. "I didn't want to read the book before I read the screenplay. And actually, it was an offer I couldn't refuse. I didn't choose it—they came to me and offered a great deal of money. Of course, I was concerned about it when I started reading the script, but Ron Samuels (her producer-manager) felt strongly about it and said that 'Scruples' was going to get lots of attention," Lindsay remarked, seeking to defend her actions.

Of course, once the deal was consummated, it didn't lessen Lindsay's lust for artistic perfection. "I feel very responsible doing the kind of work that I'm doing, and people should take responsibility. Just to get ratings is irresponsible. We affect people's lives and minds with the kind of work that we do."

"With 'Scruples,' part one needed the most work, since we needed to show the transition of Billy from an ugly duckling into a beautiful person. We had to make that part work. Of course, I didn't always agree with what had to be pulled from the book," she added.

Ms. Wagner's presence on the tube will probably diminish during the next few years, save for her ambitious 10-hour mini-series on the life of Margaret Meade, whom she called "a creative challenge to portray since she really started the beginning of the sexual

revolution and spoke her mind as a well-respected professional." But, Lindsay is hoping that 'Hawks' will accelerate her movie ambitions.

Lindsay's ascent to the top, though, hasn't been all peaches and cream. She's paid an emotional price, which the glamorous star has rectified by living away from Hollywood in her Mt. Hood, Oregon, retreat. Wagner claims, "This is absolutely necessary for me. Where I go, it's like you're in the middle of God's country." Yes, enjoying peace of mind is synonymous with success, and Lindsay now seems to have everything under control.
