We have beaten 'Eight Is Enough' four times so far, and we beat the CBS show consistently. 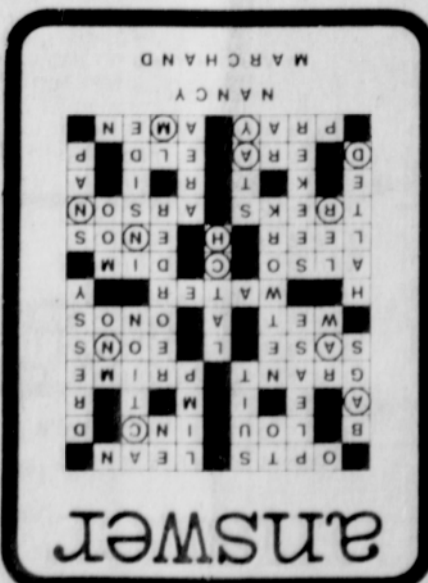
