## Renfro to resign effective June 1

Clackamas County Sheriff John Renfro said Friday he will resign effective June 1 "to give us a little cushion" in choosing a successor.

On Jan. 16, when Renfro first announced he was quitting, he said he expected to leave by Feb. 15.

"We had anticipated these things happening much faster," Renfro said in a telephone interview. "The Republican party is still taking recommendations on their recommendation (to the county commissioners for a successor)," he said.

"I certainly think we should let them take time to go through the process."

He said he thought the Republican party would need a month to decide its recommendation. Then the commissioners will choose a successor, who might need a month or two to give notice on his job and become sheriff.

"I could pack my bags and

leave and say, 'The hell with it. You guys do what you want,'" Renfro said. "But I don't think that's the appropriate way to go. I think I owe the county and my department more than that."

Since Jan. 16, the county commissioners have been waiting for Renfro's formal letter of resignation.

It arrived Thursday, but with a wording the commissioners found unacceptable.

Renfro said in the letter, "I anticipate resigning" the office of sheriff, with the "expected date" being June 1.

County counsel Michael Montgomery returned the letter to Renfro, saying he had to be more definite.

"He's either got to resign or not resign," Montgomery said Friday. "If he's thinking of resigning, that's nice for us to know. But you can't have a conditional resignation."

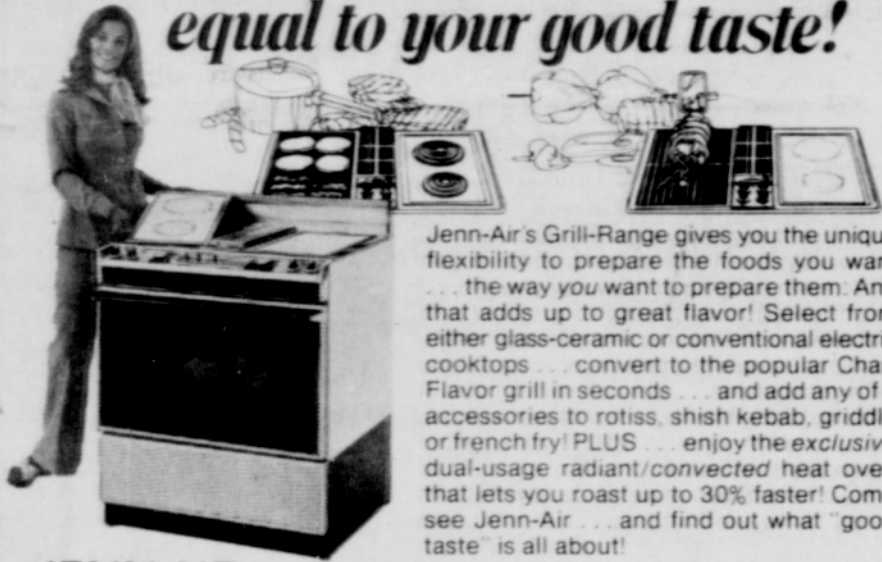
A kiln has been purchased recently for the Senior Center and a ceramic class will begin in the first part of March.

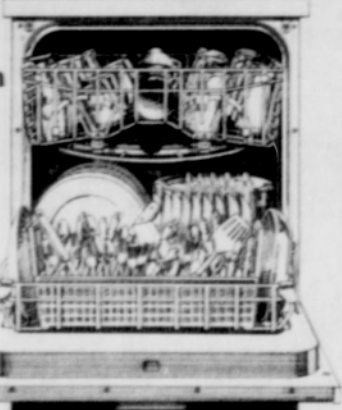

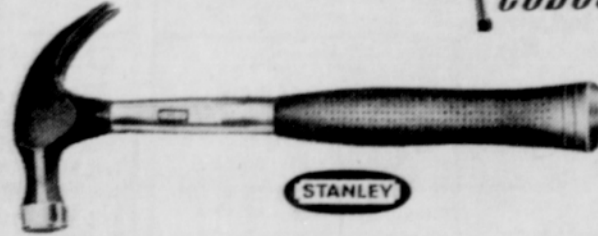
