NOTICE OF REVIEW HEARING

On September 3, 1980, at the hour of 10:00 a.m., at the Courthouse Annex, 906 Main Street, Oregon City, Oregon, the Board of County Commissioners will consider a review of the Clackamas County Hearings Officer's approval of a variance and an expansion of a non-conforming use request to expand the existing precast concrete products manufacturing plant and cedar shake mill by constructing a 16 foot by 28 foot office, lunch and wash room, a cement bin, and a 32 foot by 96 foot addition to an equipment storage building; and reduce the side yard setback for the latter

from 10 feet to 3 1/2 feet.

Unless otherwise provided by the Board of County Commissioners under Section 1304 of the Clackamas County Zoning Ordinance, the review of the decision shall be confined to the record of the proceedings before the Hearings Officer. The Board of County Commissioners may admit additional testimony and other evidence without holding a new hearing or hear the entire matter again, if it is satisfied that the testimony or other evidence could not have been presented at the initial hearing.

The party requesting review is Law Langlois et al, file number 392-80-V-E.

The review is for property generally described as follows: On the north side of State Highway 211 approximately 1/2 mile west of its intersection with S.E.

362nd Drive, in the Sandy area.

DISTRICT NO. 2 OPERATING LEVY
 QUESTION: Shall Sandy High School District levy \$1,900,702.00 outside Oregon's Constitutional limitation for operating expenses during the fiscal year 1980-81?

PURPOSE: The purpose is to fund the educational program adopted by the District for the students grades nine through twelve.
 EXPLANATION: The District does not have a tax base to provide the educational program required by statute and adopted by the District board; therefore, voter approval of an operating levy is presented to the District voters each year.
