Former Boring minister named Oswego vicar

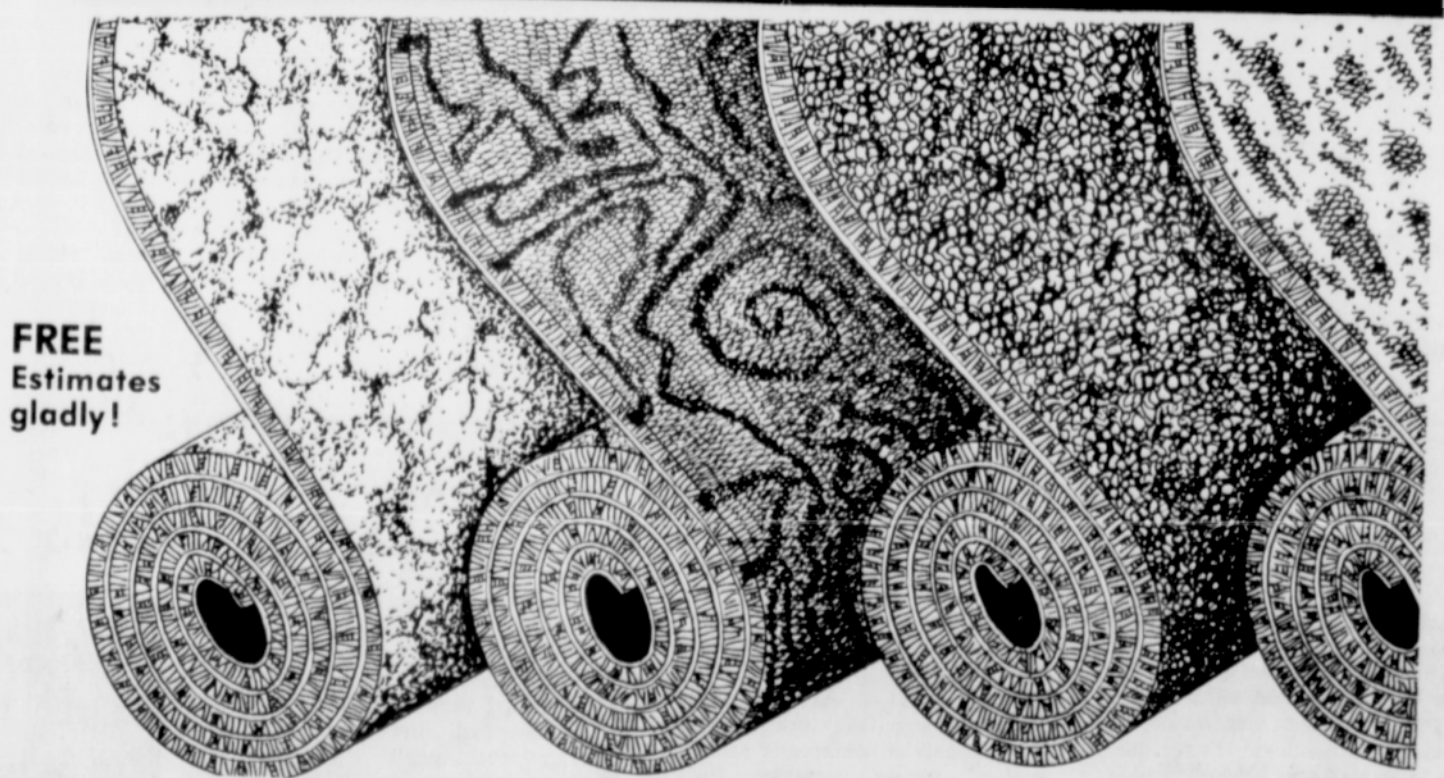
