

Property tax deferrals due for seniors

Applications for both the senior citizen's property tax deferral and veteran's property tax exemption programs are currently being accepted by Clackamas County Assessor George Malin.

A separate application for each program must be filed by April 1.

The senior citizen's deferral allows homeowners age 62 or older to delay paying property taxes on their residences. The taxes plus interest must be paid when the owner dies, sells the property or stops using it as a residence, or earns more than \$1,800 yearly from the property itself.

Owners need to sign up for the deferral only once. It continues automatically unless the owner requests the Oregon Department of Revenue, which administers the program, to discontinue it.

The veteran's property tax exemption removes \$7,500 from a home's true cash value from taxation.

10-minute lemon pie and coffee cake deluxe

SWEET AND SOUR SPARERIBS

2 tbs brown sugar
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup vinegar
1/2 cup pineapple juice
1/4 cup diced onions
1/2 cup diced green pepper
2 tbs soy sauce
1/2 tsp Worcestershire sauce
2 lbs. spareribs

Combine first nine ingredients and pour over spareribs which have been arranged in a shallow, sprayed baking dish. Bake at 350 degrees for 1 1/2 hours, basting frequently with sauce. Serves 6-4. — From the files of Marijane Jackson, Welches.

CHIPPER CHICKEN

1 medium bag potato chips
1 tsp garlic salt
1/2 tsp pepper
1/4 cup butter or margarine
1 tsp salt
2-3 lb. broiler-fryer, cut in pieces

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Crush potato chips until fine. Melt butter in frying pan and add seasonings. Roll chicken in seasoned butter, then in chips.

Place chicken in oblong pan, 9 1/2" x 13", which has been sprayed or lightly greased. Bake 1 to 1 1/2 hours until tender and a golden brown. Serves 4-6. — From the files of Netta Pfouts, Portland.

COFFEE CAKE DELUXE

3/4 cup brown sugar
3/4 cup white sugar
2 1/2 cups sifted flour
1/2 tsp salt
3/4 cup vegetable oil
1 tsp cinnamon

Mix above ingredients well, blending as you would for pastry. Take out 1 cupful to be used for top of cake. Add 1/2 cup nuts to this topping mix.

Add to remaining mixture the following:

1 egg
1 tsp soda
1 tsp baking powder
1 tsp vanilla
1 cup sour milk

Mix and pour into greased 9" x 13" pan. Sprinkle with topping mix. Bake 25 minutes at 350 degrees. — From the files of Virginia Moore, Seattle, Wash. Given to me by Mary VanLierop, Sandy.

VEGETABLE DIP

1 pkg. dried vegetable soup mix
1 pint sour cream

Mix together and let set an hour or two before serving with dip potato chips or crackers. Serves 15-20. — From the files of Dorothy Vandell, Salem. This is a little salty for my taste. You could sift out a little of the mix and omit it, or add 1/2 teaspoon sugar.

10-MINUTE LEMON PIE

1 small can lemonade concentrate, slightly thawed
1 small carton whipped topping, slightly thawed
1 can sweetened condensed milk

Few drops of yellow food coloring, if desired

Thaw lemonade and whipped topping until pliable and mix together with spatula. By hand blend in milk until thoroughly mixed. Stir in food coloring.

Turn into a baked pie shell, or a graham cracker crust. Delicious! — From the files of Mrs. Kathi Ward, Sandy. Note: If you need two pies, use 2 cans of lemonade and sweetened condensed milk and a large carton of whipped topping.

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
