Weatherization plans being taken by county

Applications are currently being accepted by the Clackamas County Weatherization Project for free home weatherization services to eligible home owners. To qualify, you must be a low-income County resident. Insulation, storm windows, weatherstripping and other energy-saving items can be provided by a weatherization crew. According to the project super-

visor, an energy savings of 40 to 60 percent can be realized following weatherization. The project is jointly funded by the State Department of Energy and Clackamas County's Employment and Training Agency. Students show skills at meet

Sandy Union High School students fared well at the recent Clackamas Regional Skills Contest Feb. 26 at Clackamas Community College.

The school sent more than 70 students to compete with students from approximately 15 area schools in tests of business skills, vocational skills, mathematics and verbal communication. The competition was sponsored by CCC and the Clackamas County Education Service District.

A team of SUHS students finished in first place in arc welding and Jeff Kersting

was the top individual in arc welding for the second year in a row, according to teacher Mike Wright. The other team member, Mike Niemeyer, finished in fourth place.

The oxy-acetylene welding team of Floyd Proctor and T.J. Lenchitsky captured second place. The machining team, Don Casey and Bryan Watts, finished fourth.

The auto mechanics team of Floyd Proctor, Mike George, Ken Priester and Todd Simpkins, was second. Simpkins was third place in the safety competition.

Forty SUHS students will now compete in the state competition April 10 and 11 at Chemeketa Community College in Salem. Last year, Kersting finished third in arc welding at that competition.

All these students are members of the Sandy chapter of Vocational Industrial Clubs of America. The local chapter won an award last fall for the largest increase in membership. The group grew by 550 percent, according to Wright.

In the business education competition, Lauri Fox was awarded fifth place in the

Accounting I competition. Jo Stedronsky and Sandy Bonner tied for sixth place in the Accounting II competition. Susan Berck was sixth in Advertising, although SUHS does not have an advertising class.

Members of the Future Business Leaders of America Club from SUHS who competed in shorthand, production typing, timings and spelling and grammar and did well were Patty Gray, Stella Landis, Nina Stankevitch and Lisa Springer, according to the club advisor.
