St. Michael's schedules open house

Late last September, parishioners of St. Michael's Catholic Church pulled up stakes and moved their church from its old Strauss Street location to a new home on Langensand Road.

The oldest church in Sandy, St. Michael's opened its doors Dec. 18, 1894, on Main Street, now Pioneer Boulevard, across from the post office. The second church, which the parish moved, was dedicated in 1919 after the original church burned in 1917.

This Sunday, the parish will host an open house to show residents of Sandy its third home in the last 90 years from 1

to 5 p.m. at 18090 Langensand Road. Refreshments will be served.

The late Jess Hite donated the new six-acre tract to the church for the purpose of building a new church. However, the cost of building a whole new facility was prohibitive and the parish decided to take the church with them when it moved.

So, amid the glitter of Portland television lights and the reminiscences of longtime Sandy residents, the church moved to its new home.

Church dedication slated

Hood View Seventh-day Adventist Church, S.E. 268th and Kelso Road, Boring, will be dedicated during special services this weekend, March 27 and 28.

It will be the climax of an idea formulated when the congregation first began meeting in Boring in 1966, said Ron Smith, pastor.

Valued at more than \$700,000, the church was built primarily with volunteer labor and was completed in two phases between 1973 and 1978. It is composed of three modules: a sanctuary in the center; a classroom section on the west; and a combination of classrooms, offices and a multipurpose room on the east. The new church has 18,360 square feet of floor

space and was built at a cost of \$506,000.

Original design concept was by Frank Shell, a Portland architect. Tom Stafford, who was pastor when construction began and is now a minister in Pasadena, Calif., will return for the dedication. The church is located on a three-acre site adjacent to the Adventist's Hood View Junior Academy.

Speaker for the 11 a.m. dedication service Saturday will be Richard D. Fearing, president of the Northwest area of the church. He is chief administrator for the church in Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Oregon and Washington.

H. Jack Harris, executive secretary of the Northwest

area, will be the speaker at the 8 a.m. consecration service. Historical highlights will be featured in the 9:30 a.m. Sabbath School service coordinated by Harold Burden, a Hood View church member.

Friday evening will include a praise and thanksgiving service at which the speaker will be Reuben Rembold, associate to Harris. The program will begin at 7:30 p.m. with a half-hour music concert.

Informal church tours will be given Saturday afternoon from 2:30 to 5:30 p.m.

Original members of the congregation came primarily from the Sandy Adventist church and met temporarily at the Boring Methodist Church.
