Teacher preaches order

Gloria Johnson used to be a disorganized person.

Now, however, she has discovered some secrets about organizing space, time and children and she will share them with Sandy area residents in three classes, beginning next Thursday, April 2.

The first class is entitled "How To Conquer Inner Space." Johnson says that it is possible to have an orderly home by storing things so you can find them when you need them.

This discussion will help class participants learn to organize their home so they can find 98 percent of their possessions within two minutes. Storage and filing systems will be presented, along with methods of fighting clutter.

The second class, April 9, is called "Work Smarter Not Harder." Organizing time enables people to do twice as much in half the time, according to Johnson.

Becoming a priority planner can save all kinds of time, she says. The ideas she will discuss in this presentation deal with time at home and on the job.
