Clothing for men, women and children will be shown, highlighting spring and summer fashions. A number of stores will be participating, including Being Beautiful,

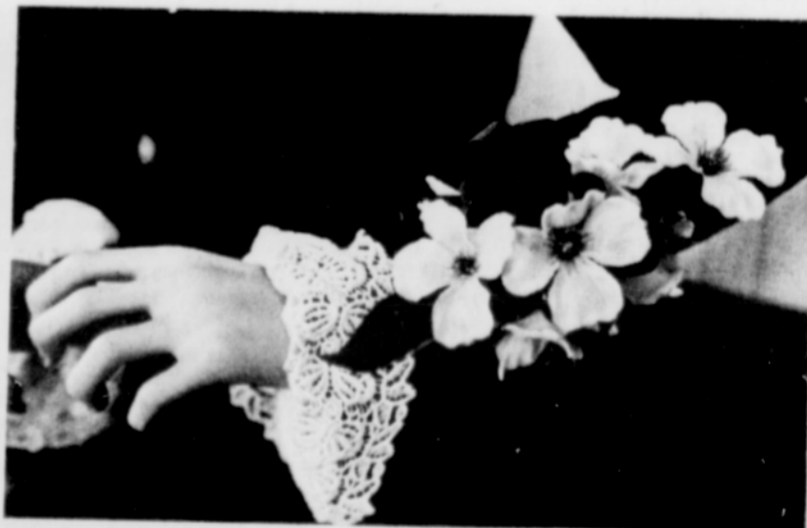
