## Exemption available for groups

Many non-profit civic and social welfare organizations can be recognized as tax-exempt by the Internal Revenue Service.

The IRS recognizes more than 20 categories of exempt organizations, but by far the most common are those qualifying as religious, charitable or educational organizations. Such organizations must file an application for exemption

from tax except for churches and certain other charitable organizations with less than \$5,000 in annual receipts.

Oregon religious, charitable or educational organizations may file "Application for Recognition of Exemption," Form 1023, with the district director of Internal Revenue in Portland. Other exempt organizations apply on Form 1024.

An organization with subordinate chapters may apply for a group exemption letter, rather than having each affiliate apply, according to the IRS.

Exempt organizations that normally have gross receipts above \$10,000 are required to file an annual Form 990, "Return of Organization Exempt from Income Tax." In addition, organizations that have at least \$1,000 in gross income from an unrelated business must file Form 990-T, "Exempt Organization Business Income Tax Return."

Examples of unrelated business income include profit from a manufacturing operation, retail sales and

proceeds from the operation of a parking lot.

More information is available in the IRS Publication 598, "Tax on Unrelated Income of Exempt Organizations," and Publication 557, "How to Apply for and Retain Exempt Status for your Organization." Both are available free from most area IRS offices or can be ordered toll-free by telephone.

The IRS examines exempt organizations to make sure they comply with the tax laws. If an examination turns up failure to comply with the legal requirements, the IRS may revoke an organization's tax-exempt status.

## Credit due contributors

If you made a political contribution in 1980, you may be eligible for a tax credit of up to \$100 on your joint return.

The credit is one-half of the amount contributed, up to the maximum of \$50 on a single return or \$100 on a joint return and may be claimed on either the Form 1040 or 1040A.

To qualify for the credit, the contributions must be made to candidates for nomination or election to a federal, state or local office in a general, primary or special election; a committee sponsoring such candidates; national, state or local committees of a national political party, or newsletter funds of an official or candidate.

More detailed information on political contributions is

contained in the Internal Revenue Service publication, "Voluntary Tax Methods to Help Finance Political Campaigns."
