New pamphlet outlines rights for renters

A new publication from the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) can help renters save both energy and money.

"Energy Tips for Renters" tells how to reduce space heating, lighting, cooking and laundry energy costs through simple, no-cost and low-cost actions. Most renters pay utility costs directly and that can amount to as much as 25 percent of the monthly rent.

Most of the booklet's tips are common sense conservation advice, such as weatherstripping around doors and windows and caulking around outside door and window frames. Other lesser-known tips include blocking cold drafts under a door with a "draft-dodger" — a cloth tube filled with sand. Or, by setting the water heater thermostat at 120 degrees instead of 140 degrees, renters can save as much as \$45 annually.

The free booklet, latest in a series of ODOE energy conservation publications, discusses how to work with landlords in making efficiency improvements, home safety and how to read electric meters.
