## Fire rates decrease in Govt. Camp

Government Camp residents received some good news this week about their fire insurance rates.

The rating in Government Camp has decreased from 10 to six, according to Hoodland Fire Chief Don Armintrout.

Fire insurance rates are determined by distances from a fire department to a dwelling. The rating of 10 is the highest for insurance premiums.

Government Camp was annexed into the Hoodland Fire District in March of 1980. The rates were reevaluated in January of this year.

The dwellings that are within 1,000 feet of a fire hydrant were given a Class 6 rating, while other buildings in a 10-mile radius were changed to Class 9. The new insurance ratings went into effect May 1.

The decrease could lower insurance rates for Government Camp residents as much as 80 percent.
