Ansel Adams speaks

Ansel Adams' training as a classical pianist has helped him in a different field: photography. The meticulous discipline he learned in his music training aided him tremendously in becoming one of the most famous and successful photographers of the day. Close friend and musician Rosario Mazzeo remarks that the subtle and wonderful tonalities of the music Adams plays are echoed in his photographs of the American west.

An intimate and sensitive portrait of the 79-year-old Adams can be seen in the special, "Ansel Adams: Photographer" to air on PBS May 13. (Local dates may vary; check listings.) Produced by Andrea Gray and John Huszar, the film allows Adams to speak for himself on his life, his 60 years of photography and his musical background.
