**Legionnaires' Disease deadly**

Legionnaires' Disease first came to public notice in 1976 at a Philadelphia convention.

But the disease doesn't strike large meetings only. It can attack at any time and when it does, the disease can spread from the lungs to other body organs.

Various American Lung Associations have sponsored seminars and scientific meetings to probe the mysteries of this still elusive lung disease.

Many facts about Legionnaires' Disease have already surfaced and some of them are ominous. Recent studies have estimated that there may be more than 71,000 deaths in adults from unrecognized Legionnaires' Disease in the United States every year. Diagnosis remains difficult.

There is new evidence that Legionnaires' Disease spreads from the lungs other than other organs in the body in one out of every four patients. The most susceptible patients are those with other diseases, such as chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, cancer and kidney ailments.

The most common victims of Legionnaires' Disease are those people over 50 years of age who smoke cigarettes. In a recent study, 85 percent of the patients smoked.

To help diagnose Legionnaires' Disease, it is suggested:

A blood culture be taken from all patients with acute pneumonia for whom no specific diagnosis has been made. A culture is a test to see if the bacteria that caused Legionnaires' Disease can be grown in a special

medium. Spread of Legionnaires' Disease should be considered if there are unexplained extrapulmonary findings in a patient.

Persons with concurrent serious illness might also be checked for Legionnaires' Disease.

Although seldom serious in form, Legionnaires' Disease is sometimes found in children, according to researchers from the University of Colorado School of Medicine.

One of the leading combatants of the disease is research, largely funded by monies received from Christmas Seal drives.

**Wilderness permits needed**

Permits will be required in 13 of the 18 wilderness areas in Oregon and Washington this summer.

Free permits will be required for all visits to Diamond Peak, Eagle Cap, Hells Canyon, Mountain Lakes, Mt. Hood, Mt. Jefferson, Mt. Washington, Strawberry Mountain and the Three Sisters Wildernesses in Oregon and for the Pasayten Wilderness in Washington.

Permits will be required only for overnight trips in the Glacier Peak, Goat Rocks and Mt. Adams Wildernesses in Washington.

No permits will be required for the Alpine Lakes Wilderness in Washington, the Gearhart Mountain, Kalmiopsis and Wild Rogue Wildernesses in Oregon and

the Wenaha-Tucannon Wilderness which is in both Oregon and Washington.

The permit system will be in effect from June 15 to Nov. 15, except for the Glacier Peak, Pasayten and Eagle Cap Wildernesses where it is in effect all year.

The permit system is part of a continuing effort to better manage the areas to prevent destruction of the wilderness values and preserve the experience sought by more hikers and equestrians each year.

Permit information helps managers relate recreational use to ecological impacts, set trail maintenance priorities and plan work for wilderness rangers.

Permits may be obtained by mail or in person for all wilderness areas in

Washington and the Eagle Cap and Hells Canyon in Oregon by applying to the National Forest administering the Wilderness to be visited. The remaining Wilderness areas in Oregon which require permits will have them available at self-service stations at each trailhead leading into the Wildernesses.

Persons starting trips in the North Cascades National Park may obtain a National Park Service permit also valid in the Glacier Peak and Pasayten Wildernesses administered by the Forest Service.

Applicants for the free permits will be told of certain restrictions, such as size of party, in some Wilderness areas.
