ESD board to meet

The Clackamas County Education Service District (ESD) board will meet in regular session this Monday, June 15, at 8 p.m.

The meeting will be held in the Boardroom of the ESD offices in Marian Hall on the Marylhurst Campus.

Items on the agenda include the ESD financial appropriations for 1981-82 and a bid award for a new printing press for the ESD print shop.

Information items on the agenda include material on summer programs for trainable mentally retarded and autistic students in the ESD's special education classrooms, and on similar programs run by the ESD at Christie School, Dammasch State Hospital and the Kerr Center for Handicapped

Children.

The board will be brought up to date on the state and federal funding picture and recent legislation that may effect ESD programs.

The ESD's role in locating a new superintendent for Damascus School will also be discussed.
